Know your universe

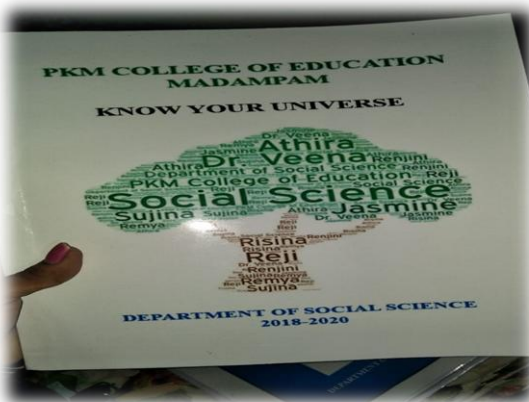
As part of our pedagogical study we prepared a General Knowledge Awareness book related with social science text book named as *know your universe* and it published by Dr. Maya J pillai.

A study of Environmental Awareness for Environmental conservation in Secondary School Students

The study is an attempt to trace out the environment awareness for environmental conservation in secondary school students. In order to make stability to this present study it is decided to collect both primary and secondary data. The primary data was collected from secondary school students by using direct personal interview. A questionnaire is used as a tool for gathering required data. In present study the investigator selected 25 respondents from different schools. In order to analyze and interpret the questionnaire score the investigator adopts the statistical techniques like mean, charts and tables etc. The study reveals that majority of the students are aware about the environmental problems and they are bothered about environment conservation. At the same time students participation in environment conservation activities are limited.

A STUDY ON SAVING BEHAVIOURS OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES IN KANNUR DISTRICT

SUJINA.T.V

This is a preliminary study of the saving pattern of the government employees. The study exclusively depends on primary data .For the purpose of collecting data 30 employees from different government departments both central and state governments, such as education, railways and banks are selected on a random basis. The sample consists 15 male and 15 female employees. The socio economic statuses of the employees are studied on the basis of their age, sex, marital status, place of residence, education and income and expenditure. To find out the financial saving behavior of employees' data on savings and the pattern of investment of saving by male and female employees are collected. Statistical tools like percentages, charts and tables are used for analysis of data. This study shows that, Gender differences in the saving behavior are only marginal. There are also not much differences in the socio economic conditions of men and women employees under study.
