Kerala Flood 2018-19

Beginning of August 15th 2018, severe floods are affected in Kerala, due to high rainfall during the monsoon season. It was the worst flooding in Kerala. Over 483 people died and 15 were missing. All 14 districts were placed on red alert. Kerala received monsoon rainfall which was about 256% more than the usual rainfall in Kerala. Almost 370 people died and 33000 peoples were rescued. Over 3274 relief camps were opened in various locations to provide shelter to those who were affected by flood. There were 40 helicopters, 30 aircraft and 182 teams for rescue. A total of 4537 from the fisherman took part in the rescue operation with 669 fishing boat. The government should take necessary steps to solve the problem of flood and find solutions to overcome them. This project clearly describes Kerala Flood 2019 and it's aftermaths.

Quiz Competition on Indian Constitution and Republic

On 24/01/2020 Social Science Department conducted a Quiz competition based on the topic "Indian Constitution and Republic" which was held in the general classroom of P.K.M College of Education.
