Semester-I

1. Vibe Talk

PKM College of Education Malayalam Department 2023-2025 batch conducted a programme “Vibe Talk” to know more about the characteristics of adolescence and their peculiarities. The Head of the Department, Minimol George, led the session.

- To create confidence while speaking and writing English language.

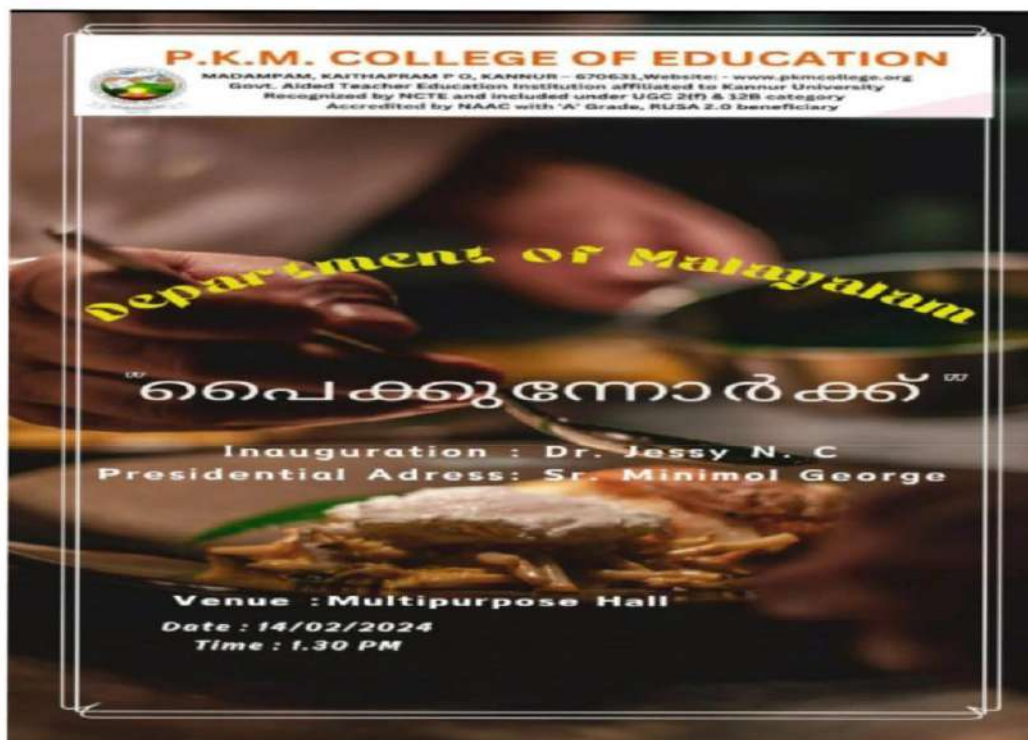
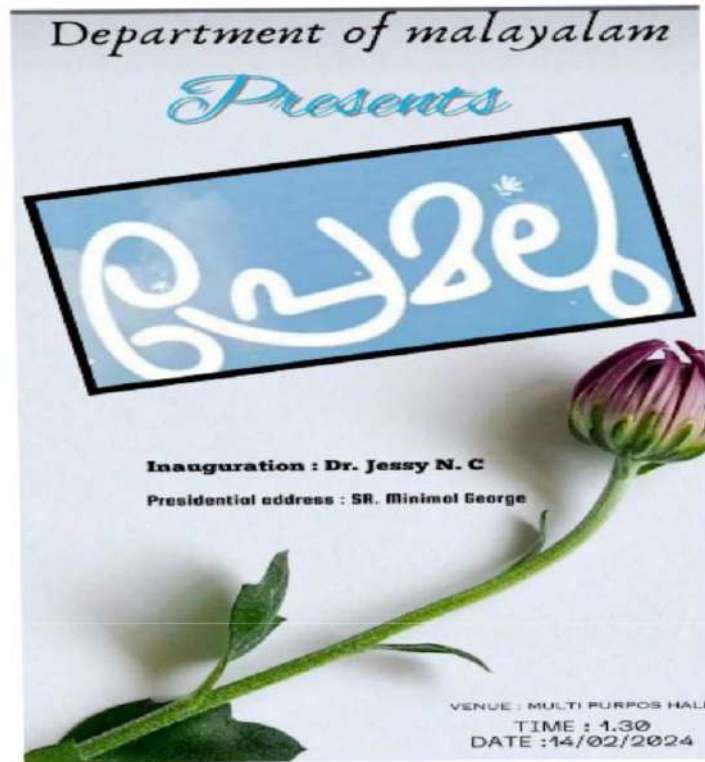


Semester-2
