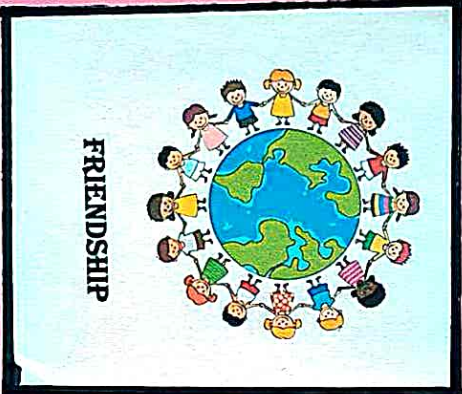

It was really colorful,

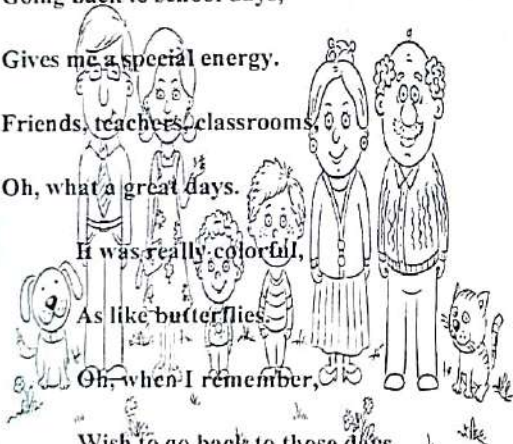
As like butterflies.

It captured my heart and soul

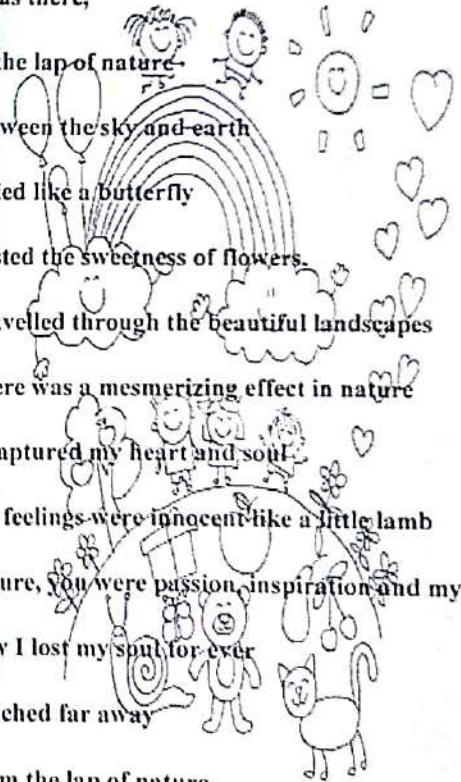
My feelings were innocent like a little lamb

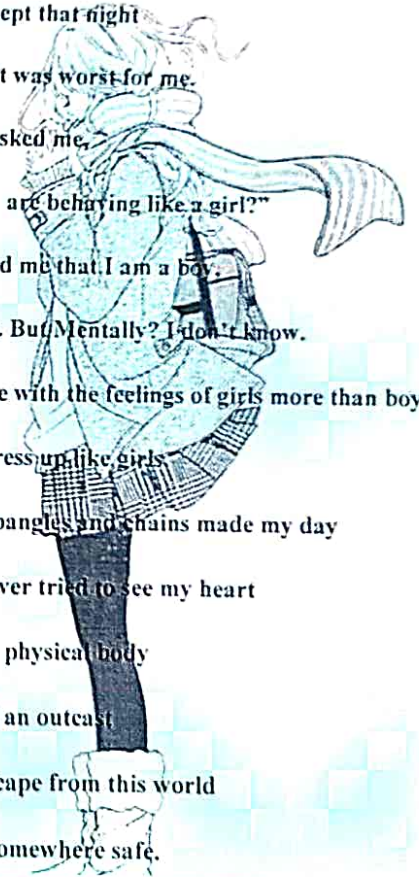
I am I
