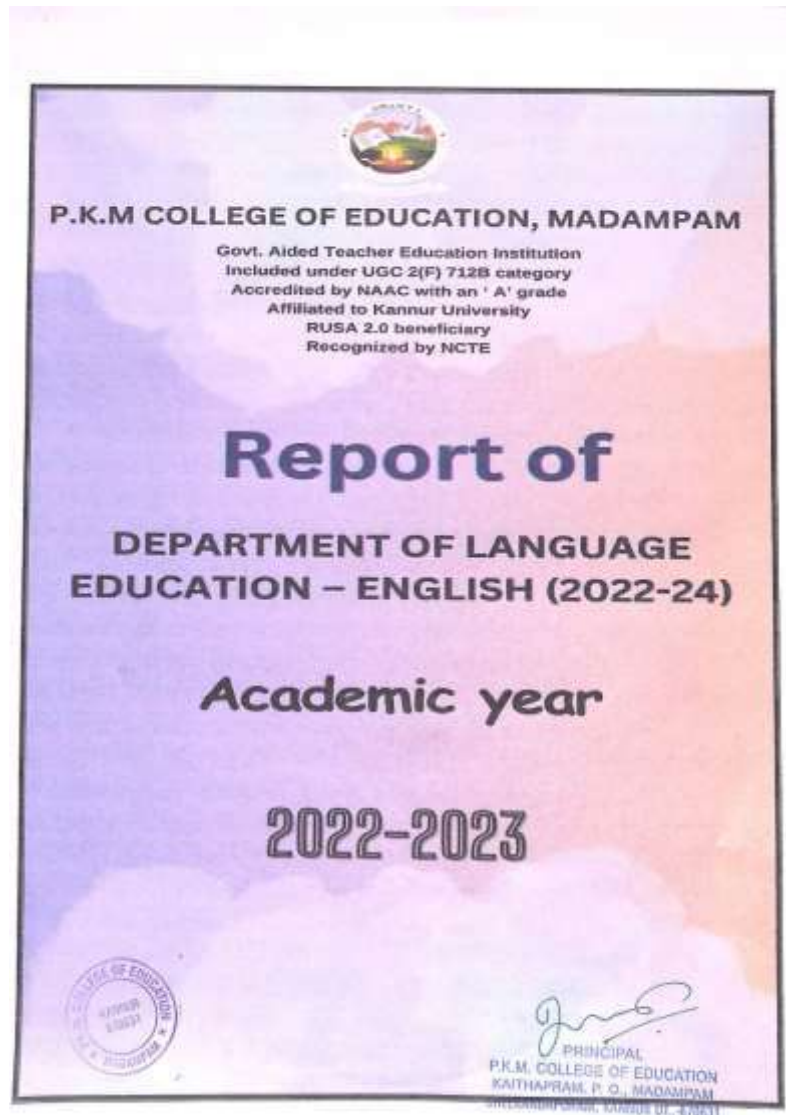

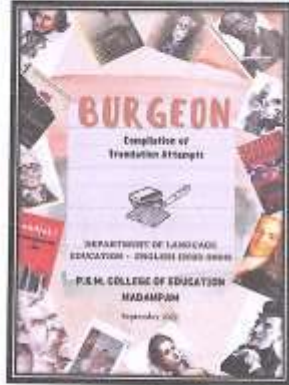

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BURGEON

Burgeon – a collection of translations was released by Dr. Jessy N C – principal, by handing it over to Dr. Prashanth Mathew- the vice principal. Ms. Christy Maria Joy, the associate editor, introduced the compilation to the audience. Burgeon includes translations of various works and genres from different languages. Some of the student teachers have done the translations of their work too. Dr.Rekha K R – the chief editor has translated two Malayalam poems by Sachi – a Malayalam film director, condensed with emotions and realities of life into English. Ms. Arsha V took some poems from O.N.V. Kurupp's Anthology "*Aathmageethangal*" and William Blake's poem Eternity and translated them into both languages. Ms. Anagha V J and Ms. Devika K K translated their work; a short story and an essay into English respectively. The story is rooted in a depressed individual's loneliness and emotional imbalances. The essay covered various aspects of COVID-19 and its effect on contemporary society. Mr. Jyothis Cyriac and Ms. Shahana Farveen translated the works of Vikram Seth and Katherine Tynan. "*Any Woman*" strongly portrays the role of the female in a well-structured society. Jyothis' translated work could touch the hearts of many as it is a reflection of modern man who lives in the absurdities of the world. Ms. Christy Maria Joy translated a poem "*Nee*" by her friend, Gopika, which voices the speaker's desire to dissolve in her lover. Sr.Josna Jose has done the translation of famous quotes from the Bible as well as the words of Mahatma Gandhi, Buddha, etc.

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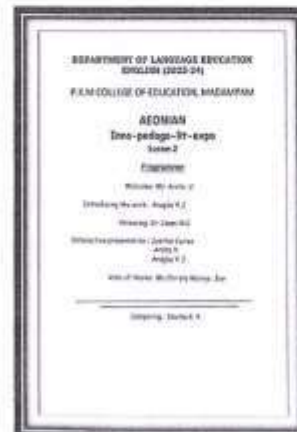

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K. K, the creative editor, is to be specially acknowledged. This attempt seeks to create an interest in learning the English language.





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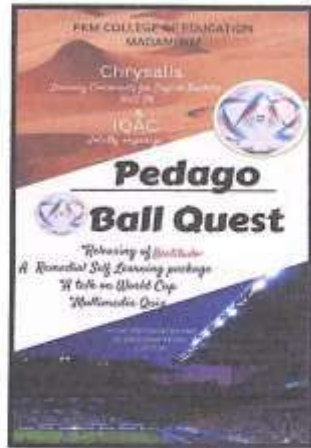
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Pedago Ball Quest

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Multimedia Quiz

As part of Pedago Ball Quest a multimedia quiz was conducted by I Q A C and Chrysalis a learning community for English teachers on 16th December 2022. It was a striking and novel experience for P K M College of Education. Mr. Jyothis Cyriac from 1st B Ed English was the quiz master who dealt with the quiz in a creditable way. It was organized into six different rounds namely preliminary, audio, video, audio-video, buzzer, and rapid fire. In the preliminary round, the participation of all 50 students was ensured, and a Google form consisting of 12 questions was circulated among the group. Those who submitted the response within 2 minutes were shortlisted and the following student teachers were selected for the second phase.

In the first round, each pair was supposed to identify the name of the game from the audio played. In the second round, a video was displayed on the screen and the participants were instructed to answer the question based on that. Thirdly a short feature about a sportsperson and their uniqueness was shown and questions were framed out of that video. The next round was the buzzer round and it was done by using a digital buzzer to ask questions. The final round was a rapid-fire session where five consecutive questions were asked for each group and they had to answer them respectively. All the rounds were interesting as well as informative. The active participation of the audience was also commendable.

Team Gryffindor- Akhil C K and Harikishor K V were the champions with 172 points and Ravenclaw- Akshay Sukumaran and Hariprasad N and Slytherin Nirmal John and Aiswarya P V

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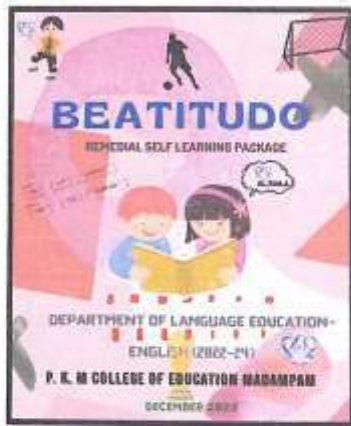
BEATITUDO

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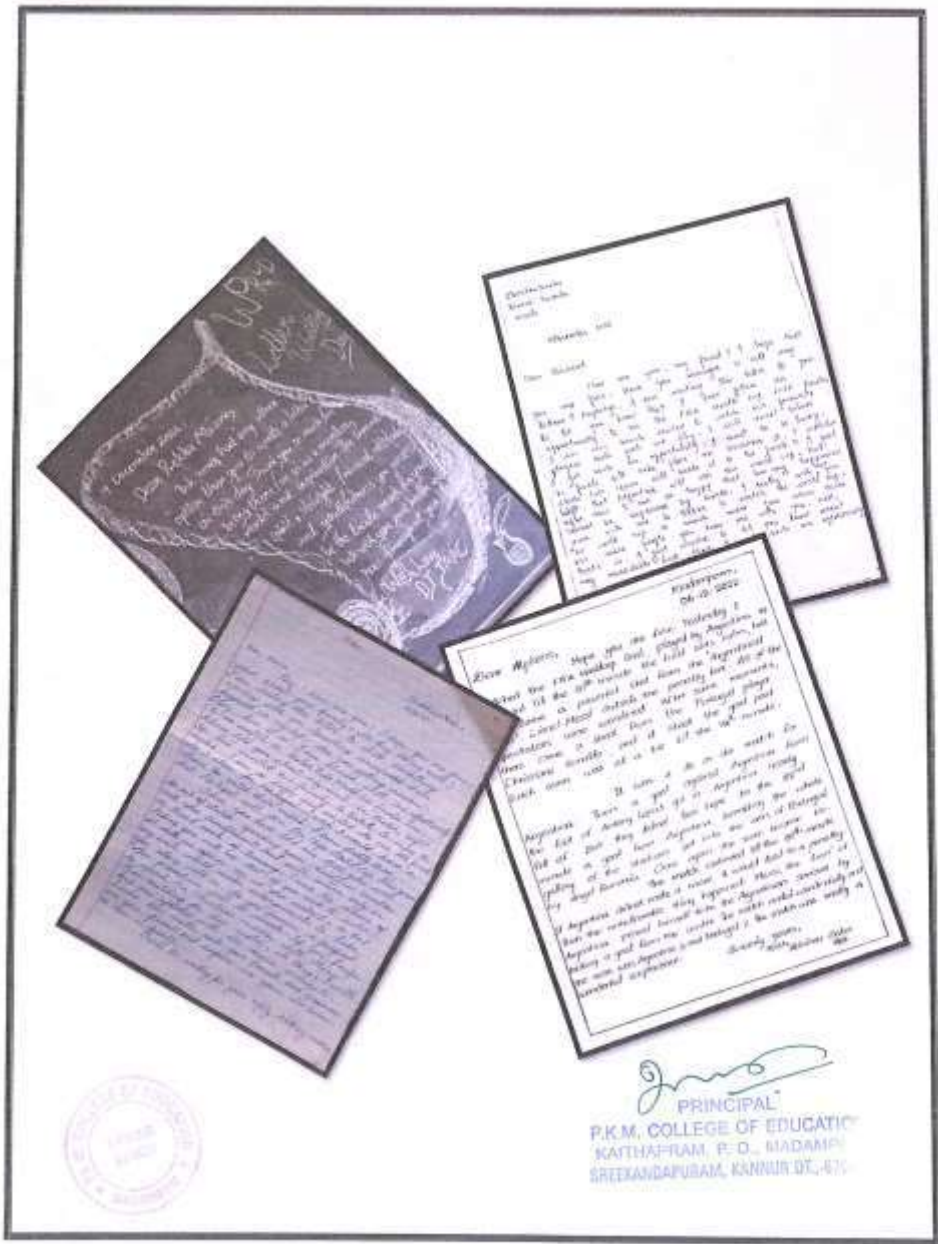
LETTER WRITING DAY

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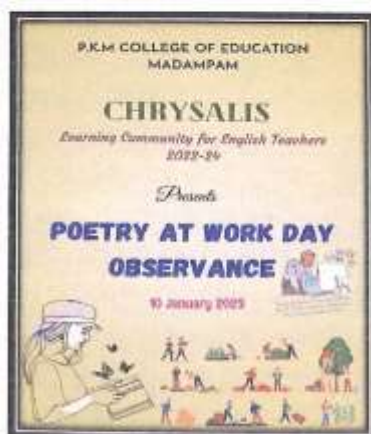
POETRY AT WORK DAY

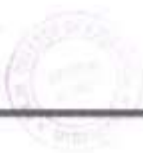

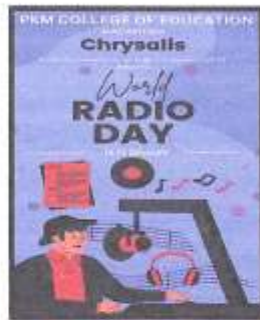



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WORLD RADIO DAY OBSERVANCE

EUPHONIA



Chrysalis, the Learning Community for English Teachers 2022-2024 of the P.K.M. College of Education, Madampam, celebrated World Radio Day on 13 February 2023. As part of the Observance the team developed a Radio script which was recorded and presented. The lesson from the eighth standard reader *The Last Leaf* a short story by O Henry is presented as a radio play. Then other chapters from the same reader are analyzed and presented. For entertainment, some advertisements were also made based on some Pedago literary products developed by the Chrysalis group. Meanwhile, some grammar activities are also included in it.

Radio has been the long-standing medium of expression and the most influential mass media. This day is celebrated with different broadcasts, online activities, community events, and awards. On Nov 3, 2011, UNESCO declared February 13 as World Radio Day because on this day United Nations Radio was first established in 1946. It is observed to preserve the importance of radio as well as to encourage decision-makers to provide access to information through radio. UNESCO coordinates World Radio Day activities on a global scale with UN member countries through their radio stations. The theme for World Radio Day 2023 is 'Radio and Peace' which focuses on the role of radio as an independent medium of peacemaking. The sub-theme of the day is 'Radio in Conflict Prevention and Peacebuilding' and 'Support to Independent Radio'.

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Radio script writing simply means writing in the language of radio, so now we can do the transformational change of language as a discourse. It is also true that radio script writing is more challenging than other kinds of writing. We observed the day by developing a session at Chrysalis Radio Station by assuming the role of radio jockeys. This program helped us to enrich our knowledge of writing a radio script and the task behind it. The language of the radio is simple and should be clear. In the pedagogic sense, we had included so many things like poem recitation, enriching the grammatical elements through emphasizing the listening skill. The first chapter. The *Jungle Air crash* a short story in the first-person point of view was paraphrased and converted into a third-person point of view. As a team it brought us multidimensional benefits - radio script writing and development then secondly helps us to improve our pronunciation, intonation, accent, stress, and other things related to Phonetics. And also, as part of radio day for increasing listening comprehension we developed a listening comprehension kit based on passages created by ourselves.




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MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY



As part of Mother Language Day Chrysalis, a learning community for English teachers organized the day observance program Linguae Nutrices on 21 February 2023. The name of the program denotes the role of language teachers as nurses of language. The program began at 11 am in the English class cum method lab. Ms. Devika K.K gave the welcome Speech. Jyothis Cyriac delivered introductory remarks wherein he highlighted the importance of the mother language in the history of humankind and how it helps to preserve our rich heritage and culture. 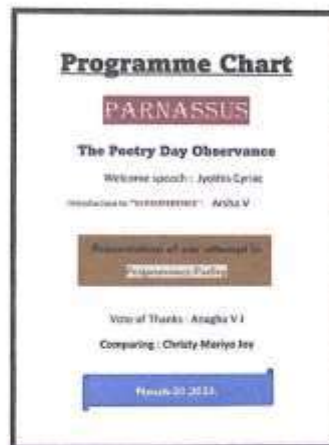

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WORLD POETRY DAY OBSERVANCE

The official titled Parnassus program started by recalling the American poet Robert Frost's line: "Poetry is when an emotion has found its thought and the thought has found words".

Mr. Jyoths Cyriac welcomed the gathering with his thought-provoking words. Major poets from literary history and their vision of poetry were duly emphasized in the welcome note. Versoference – A repertoire of poetics, and reference material was introduced by Ms. Arsha V. She has pointed out the multidimensional pedagogic exercises involved in its creation. Afterward Versoference – the publication was

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released by the optional teacher Dr. Rekha K R by handing it over to Ms. Anagha V J, and an online presentation of the same was also conducted.

As part of the observance team, Chrysalis has attempted to make a step toward the genre of performance poetry. The poems from various languages were chosen, composed, and recorded by the members themselves. 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GRAMMAR DAY OBSERVANCE




Day Observance

National Grammar Day

National Grammar Day was established in 2008 in the US by Martha Brockenbrough, the founder of the Society for the Promotion of Good Grammar to raise awareness about the significance of using good grammar. The motto for the day is "It's not just a date, it's a command: On March 4, speak well, write well, and help others do the same!". The peculiarities of the language are commemorated on this day by giving special emphasis to the study of grammar and its rules. To use language understandably, one should have proper knowledge of grammar, which adds to the significance of this day's observance in the teaching-learning process.

As part of the grammar day observance, *Chrysalis*, the learning community for English teachers (2022-24 batch) has released an animation video named *Grammapolis*. 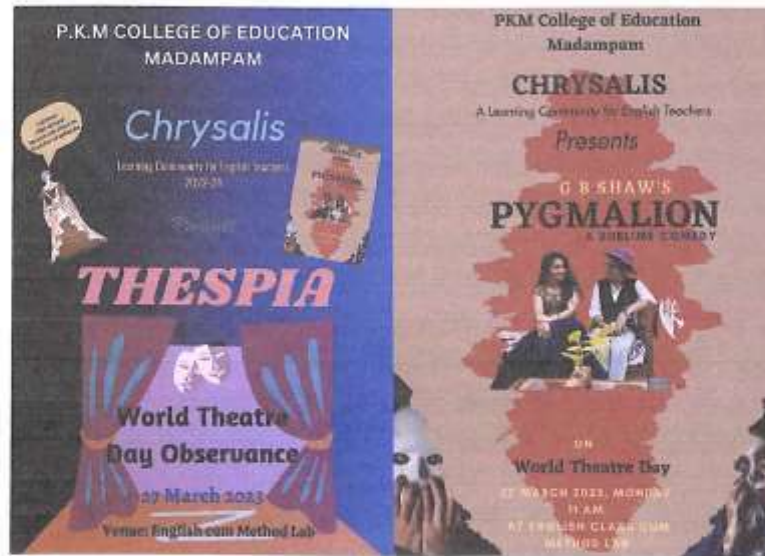


THESPIA

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SEMESTER REPORT 2021-23

English Optional

Third Semester: 12th September 2022 – 31st January 2023

The third-semester classes for the academic year 2021-23 commenced on 12th September 2022. The seven teacher aspirants prepared and relished the first teaching practice during the internship that dominated the third semester of the B.Ed. course. The student-teachers indulged in the pre-internship activities, engaged in the internship period, and attended the post-internship works that consolidated the third-semester programs. It concluded on 31st January 2023.

Pre-Internship

➤ Pre-Internship Orientation Class

Pre-internship orientation program for English was organized by P. K. M. College of Education, Madampam on 24th September 2022 at 09:45 am. T. M. Ramachandran of GHSS, Nedungome was invited as the district resource person who had a rich knowledge of the pedagogy of the English language. Dr. Rekha K


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R, assistant professor, delivered the welcome address. The class consisted of various language games, a discussion on grammar rules, and discourses, and an interactive session with the resource person. Mr. Ramachandran stressed the need for preparation, confidence in the content to be taught, and the need for interactive, activity-based classes where learners can learn freely. The program came to an end with a vote of thanks proposed by the student-teacher Karishma Suresh at 01:00 pm.

➤ **Criticism Class**

Criticism classes were conducted on the 26th and 27th of September 2022 at Maryland High School, Madampam. The student-teachers selected high school classes according to their interests and handled different subunits of standard 8 and 9 English readers. The classes began at 9.30 a.m.

On 26th September 2022, Karishma Suresh handled the subunit *The Jungle Air Crash* for the 9th standard learners. The second hour of the D division of the 8th standard was handled by Reshma G R. The subunit chosen by her was *A Day in the Country*. The last class of the first day of criticism class was handled by Anusree K. The subunit chosen was *The Trio*.

Evaluation of the classes was conducted in the afternoon session.

Dr. Rekha K R, Associate Professor in English P K M College of




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Education Madampam led the evaluation session of the classes. The teacher educator pointed out the positives and negatives of the classes conducted in the forenoon session based on the observation.


The second day of the criticism class started at 09.30 am and ended at 12.30 p.m. The student-teachers Dariya Baby, and Aswathi. V, Amitha George, and Jinisha John handled the classes. Aswathi V handled the first period of the 9th standard. The subunit chosen was *The Last Leaf*. The second, third, and fourth periods in the D division of the 8th standard were handled by Amitha George, Dariya Baby, and Jinisha John. The evaluation session of the classes was conducted on 28th September 2022. The classes were critically analyzed and the areas of defects and merits were discussed in detail.

The second round of criticism classes was conducted on 29th September 2022. It was handled by Amitha George, Jinisha John, and Dariya Baby in their peer group. The classes were critically evaluated by the student-teachers and teacher educators.

Internship

➤ GHSS Sreekandapuram

The internship programme began on 1st October 2022. Reshma G R, the student teacher from English optional along with twelve


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trainees from other optional classes were assigned to work in GHSS Sreekandapuram during their internship programme. Two classes were assigned to the student teacher initially. The classes allotted were 8B and 9 B. Jaya Jose and Jobesh Joseph were the supervising teachers of each class respectively. During the internship, the student teacher performed a major role in Arts Day, the Annual Sports Meet, and the Keralapiravi celebration. During the internship period, the student teacher observed the classes of the peer group and regular teachers of the school as mentioned above. As part of this, classes of five teachers of different subjects were observed. As the part of internship programme, the student teacher conducted a story writing competition and essay writing competition in association with the unit 'Dawn of Hope' in the 9th standard. Certain vocabulary games were also conducted in both classes. On December 1st, 2022, the student teacher shifted her teaching practice to a higher secondary stream. There she was assigned to the charge of H2 B. The internship program came to an end on 23rd December 2022.


➤ **GHSS Nedungome**

Anusree K, Jinisha John, and Karishma Suresh, the English optional student-teachers of PKM College of Education, Madampam completed their internship at GHSS Nedungome from




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1st October 2022 to 23rd December 2022. The training was completed in VIII, IX, and XI standards. The classes allotted to Anusree K, Jinisha John, and Karishma Suresh were 8C and 9B, 8A and 9A and 8B respectively under the supervising teachers Farhana, Dhanya, Treesa Mariya Thomas and T M Ramachandran in high school; and C1, H1 and S1 classes in higher secondary respectively under the supervising teachers Jobi Mathew and. The student-teachers actively participated in most school-related programs and events. Various programs were conducted under the categories of academic, communal, cultural, inclusive education, sports, and arts. Try Me Daily Puzzle, Weekly Newspaper, and Talk Masters Elocution Workshop were the programs conducted as part of English language learning. The students of the school were also trained for the National Roleplay Competition and Skit (English) by the student-teachers under the supervision of T M Ramachandran, an English teacher at GHSS Nedungome. During the internship period, the student-teachers also observed the classes of peer groups and regular teachers to elevate their understanding of the teaching and learning process. They also engaged in free classes of primary and upper primary sections with various language games and activities. The internship program came to an end on 23rd December 2022.


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➤ **GHSS Irikkur**

The school internship programme was initiated from 1st October 2022 to 23rd December 2022. The student-teachers, Amitha George and Aswathi V from the English optional together with thirteen other student-teachers were assigned to work in GHSS Irikkur. The classes allotted for Amitha George and Aswathi V were 8 D and 9 B, and 8 C and 9 D respectively. Amitha George was supervised by Ms. Dhanya Mol Puthussery and Mr. Sajith Kumar. The supervisors of Aswathi V were Ms. Dhanya Mol Puthussery and Ms. Revathy. Various roles were decorated by the student-teachers in the academic, cultural, community, sports, and administrative activities of the school. Classroom observation of the peers and regular teachers was done properly. Word games, vocabulary games, and World Cup quizzes were conducted in the high school classes by the student-teachers. From December 1st onwards the internship program was extended to the UP section for Aswathi V and the HSS section for Amitha George. The classes allotted for Aswathi V were 7A and 6 E, while plus one commerce, science, and humanities were assigned to Amitha George. Various roles including exam duty were executed by the student-teachers.

➤ **Sacred Heart HSS Payyavoor**


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Dariya Baby, the student-teacher from English optional along with a trainee from another social science optional class was assigned to work at Sacred Heart HSS Payyavoor during their internship programme from 1st October 2022 to 23rd December 2022. Several programs and activities were conducted during the internship period. Competency tests in listening, speaking, reading, and writing were conducted in classes 8 and 9. A drama based on the subunit *Rosa Parks Sat Still* was also held in class 8. Similarly, group activities and vocabulary games related to the subunits were conducted for the learners in class 9. Other programs like IT quizzes, school elections, sociology fairs, football championships, SPC parade, curriculum reformation, Kerala *piravi*, anti-drug human chain, arts festival (district), and national unity event took place in the school.

Post-Internship

➤ Model Classes for the Practical Examination

To prepare the student teachers for the third-semester practical examination, the student-teachers of English optional 2021-23 took model classes from 17th January to 19th January 2023. All the student-teachers selected a topic from 8/9th std SCERT English Reader and prepared lesson plans and learning aids for it. On-17th




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January, Ms Anusree K and Ms Jinisha John took classes in the afternoon session. After the classes, a discussion on their classes and lesson plans was done, and the student teachers gave their feedback and suggestions in the light of the discussion. On 18th January, Ms. Amitha George, Ms Reshma G R, and Ms. Aswathi V took classes and received comments and suggestions from the rest of the class in the afternoon session. The model classes by Ms. Karishma Suresh and Ms. Dariya Baby were done on 19th January 2023. Based on the suggestions given by the peer group, the student-teachers have made changes in their lesson plans and helped them to prepare well for their practical examination.

➤ **Submission of Records**

The student-teachers of English Optional 2021-23 engaged in their record work from 2nd January to 13th January 2023. The final corrections in the seven records - A record of practice teaching, a record of learning aids, a record of observation of a regular classroom teacher, a record of an achievement test, action research, a reflective journal, and a work diary- were done considering the comments and suggestions provided by the teacher educator Dr. Rekha K R. The teacher educator and the principal certified the records by 23rd January 2023.


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➤ **Literary Meeting**

Crescendo – The Literary Learning Community of English Teachers 2021-23 held a literary meeting in the third semester to engage in the pedagogic activities that enrich the teaching and learning skills of the student-teachers.

The members observed the science fiction day on 18th January 2023 which falls on 2nd January 2023. The day is celebrated on the birth date of famed science fiction writer Isaac Asimov, who edited or wrote more than 500 books in various genres such as science fiction, mysteries, and fantasy. Science fiction and fantasy expand horizons and open new worlds for their readers.

The student-teachers celebrated this day by revisiting the creative works on science fiction and providing individual specific views on it. The creative works included both science fiction novels and movies. Reshma G R, Aswathi V, and Dariya Baby went through sci-fi novels while Amitha George, Jinisha John, Anusree K, and Karishma Suresh shared their perspectives on sci-fi movies.

Individual views were discussed and the ideas were consolidated into a manuscript named Fanta-Sci under the leadership of student-teacher Aswathi V.

➤ **Preparation for State Eligibility Test**





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Student-teachers who are appearing for the SET carried out the discussion of the previous year's question paper and the pattern of question papers. Four student teachers applied for the SET namely Karishma Suresh, Anusree K, Reshma G R, and Jinisha John. The first day of discussion was conducted on 17th January 2023. The discussion was led by Ms. Reshma G R, student-teacher, English optional, and other student-teachers too participated in the discussion. The question paper of July 2021 was solved by the student teachers. The second third and fourth day of discussion (18th, 19th, and 21st January) was led by Anusree K and Karishma Suresh respectively. The question papers of three consecutive years were discussed.

➤ **Seminar Presentation**

Presentation of seminar papers based on the theory paper Pedagogy of School Subjects part two took place from 16th January to 20th January 2022. The session started on 16th January with the presentation of the topics TPCK, its scope, and challenges by the student teacher Reshma G R. In that paper, she presented the importance of technological knowledge and how it can be included effectively in the teaching process. The next paper was presented by Anusree K in module 3. In that paper, she included the importance of teaching and learning resources. The third paper




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was presented by Jinisha John. In that paper, she presented the significance of e-learning and e-teaching. On 7th January the student teacher Aswathi V presented a paper on research inputs in English language learning. In that paper, she included the steps of action research and place of English language as a source of knowledge. On 18th January a paper on teachers and the teaching profession was presented by Daria Baby. In that paper, she explained the professional traits and ethics of a teacher. On 20th January papers were presented by Amitha George and Karishma Suresh on TPCK-based content analysis and; the qualities and roles of a teacher respectively.

➤ **Model Exam and Viva Report**

The internship program and associated academic activities were guided with the staunch support of Dr. Rekha K R, staff advisor, English optional. The student-teachers relished the first taste of teaching for a brief period of three months giving fresh awakening to dreams of carving a generation. The teacher educator provided relentless guidance, assistance, suggestions, and constructive criticism to shape the budding teachers into a better educator. 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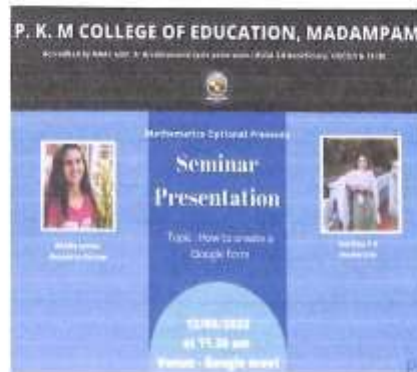

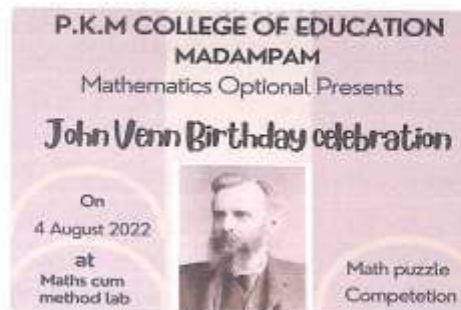

11. Math 2.0 Day

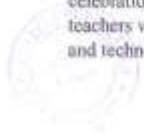

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TREASURE HUNT

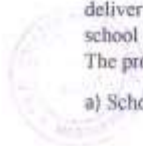

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DIACON – DIABETES AWARENESS PROGRAMME & E-BOOKLET PUBLICATION

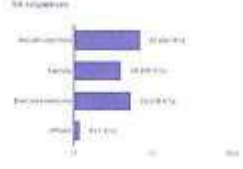

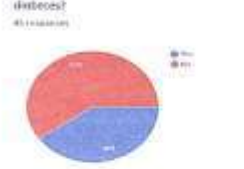



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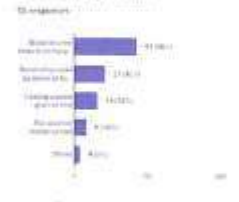

The second group of survey contained 9 student teachers of the college from different optional subjects. The field of survey was the P. K. M. College- Madampam road. Survey started at 9:45 different plant families. Further procedures were done after reaching college. The team reached college at 11.30 am .The group had a thorough observation of the area and collected




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about 30 plant materials including shrubs and herbs of different plant families.

The third group contained 8 student teachers of the college which was headed by Hariprasad N and Aiswarya P V. The field of survey was Madampam – Amabatharu road. Survey started at 10.00 am and each of the students collected plants from the allotted area. The group moved along the road upto 2 km and collected almost 33 plants including Trees, shrubs and also herbs of different families. The collected plant specimens were pressed on the site itself

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In the academic year 2022 -2023 we had conducted different innovative and unique activities. We had conducted Environment day, World Diabetes Day, Diabetes Survey, Herbarium Workshop, Biodiversity Awareness & Extension Programme, Science Magazine, World Water Day & World Forestry Day, different competitions, video preparations and presentations, paper presentations etc. We submit this report for further verifications.




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PROJECT

As part of the first semester of B.Ed. curriculum, Natural Science optional of P.K.M. College of Education conducted a project on Biodiversity survey on 3rd December 2022. Student teachers of Natural Science optional conducted the survey by grouping into 3. Three separate locations in Madampam were assigned to each group. At least 8-10 plants had to be collected by each pupil. The survey started at 9:45am.

Student teachers of Natural Science Blessy Joy, Anju M J and Linet Teresa Mathew make up the first group, they were allowed to collect plants from P.K.M. College of Education Madampam road. The group observed the allotted area and collected about 25 plants. From there itself the collected plant materials are pressed and pictures regarding the whole procedure were taken.

The second group members were Sahala Yasmin, Sheethal C and Sreelakshmi V P. They were permitted to collect plants from surroundings of P.K.M. College of Education. The collected materials includes herbs and shrubs of different families and they pressed the plant materials on site. More than 20 plants were collected by second team.

Aiswarya P V and Hariprasad N together constituted third group. The field of survey was Madampam -56 road. The group moved along the road up to 2 km and collected almost 20 plants from the allotted area.

The three groups reached the college by 12:00 pm with about 70 plants. Then started to identify the scientific name and families of the pressed plants. After the identification process, the plants were classified according to the Bentham and Hooker system of classification. The collected angiosperms (Flowering plants) were classified into 28 families and pteridophytes into 2 families. The collected plants were kept in the Natural Science classroom for further procedure. The 8 student teachers of Natural Science optional enthusiastically participated in the survey. The day made more informative.




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- **PREPARED DISCUSSION LESSON PLANS**

To familiarize with lesson planning student teachers discussed the various instructional objectives and activities in groups and prepared five discussion lesson plans based on the topics in high school biology. Given an orientation to lesson plan writing, its objectives, steps involved, pattern, procedure, critical evaluation etc. Then one discussion lesson plan session was conducted for whole group. Directed, guided them in throughout the session. Then divided the students in to two groups and conducted two discussion lesson plan preparation session. Given corrections and after modifications the students were submitted five discussion lesson plans.

- **PREPARED DEMONSTRATION LESSON PLANS**

Conducted five demonstration lesson plan sessions. Given the links of class videos of Victors channel. Given directions to observe the classes and for preparing lesson plans on demonstration classes. After the five sessions the students were prepared five discussion lesson plans and submitted. The demonstration lessons helped to develop observation skills and learned the patterns and teaching skills used in the constructivist classrooms

- **CRITICISM CLASSES**

Criticism classes were conducted for seven students in natural science where prepared one criticism lesson plans and submitted. corrections and modifications were given. Then each one had taken a criticism class and recorded it. The recorded video of the classes were digitalized. Later conducted a criticism sessions for each student to critically evaluate the classes. Critically evaluated different teaching skills of each student and pointed out strength and weaknesses and given suggestions for improvement. The students made the initial attempt to execute the lesson plan. Most of the students were presented the class with confidence. They understood their strength and weaknesses. The teacher educator peer group had given the suggestion for improvement.

- **REMEDIAL CRITICISM SESSION**

Remedial criticism session was conducted after criticism classes. After the suggestions and corrections student teachers revealed a positive improvement in their teaching.




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- **ACADEMIC COUNSELLING ON INTERNSHIP – INTERACTIVE SESSION**

Conducted an Interactive session on Internship was conducted. Discussed about Profession, Teaching profession, qualities and skills required for a teacher, professional quality, commitment, teaching behaviour, inter personal, intra personal skills required. Also discussed about the challenges in teaching and how to overcome it and how to adapt and how to become an efficient teacher with social commitment.

- **PRE-INTERNSHIP ORIENTATION**



A pre-internship orientation on recent trends in lesson plan preparation, teaching learning process and evaluation was organised by department of Natural science on 24th September 2022. The resource person was Mr. Vinod kumar K, State resource person HSS, Mambalam. The




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session was highly informative and eye-opening session. The student teachers got a new experience on real classroom teaching and the resource person was highly experienced and talented person.

- **PRACTICE TEACHING**

Done a 4 months school internship programme. Student teachers were participated in different school activities, summary preparations, home works corrections, test preparations etc. Directed them in all activities in school internship programme. They developed skills in teaching, organizing different activities, homework correction, test preparation etc. They were practiced to manage works in schools, interact with students, teachers etc.

(22nd September 2022)



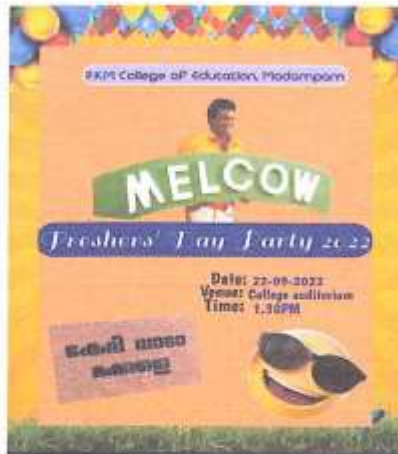

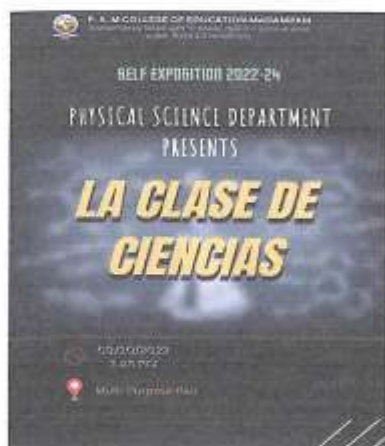



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SELF EXPOSITION- "LA CLASE DE CIENCIAS"

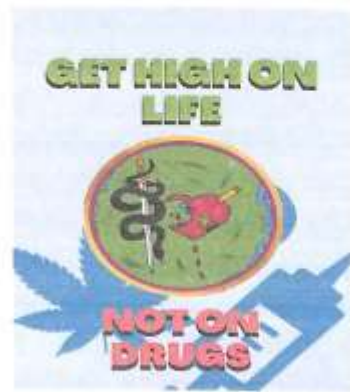

 THREE DAY PANEL DISCUSSION
 "SCIENCE IS WHAT SCIENTISTS DO"
 (14th, 17th & 18th December 2022)



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Day 1:

The Physical Science department of P.K.M. College of Education, Madampam, conducted a Panel Discussion on the topic "Science is what Scientists Do" on 14/10/2022 at 1.30 pm. Ms. Anusha V (2022-2024 batch) served as the program host. Ms. Ann Maria Raju gave the opening remarks. Dr. Prasanth Mathew presented the theme of the discussion as he welcomed everyone. The panelists were Mr. Nived C M (M Ed Scholar, School of Pedagogical Sciences, Kannur), Mrs. Manjusha K (M Ed Scholar, School of Pedagogical Sciences, Kannur), Mrs. Anusree C K (M Ed Scholar, School of Pedagogical Sciences, Kannur University).

What is science? Was the opening question posed by Dr. Prasanth Mathew, Head of the department in the physical science who moderated the panel discussion. One of the panelists, Mrs. Manjusha, provided a brief explanation of the question. According to her, "Science is a corpus of knowledge, and we are its product." Based on this assertion, Dr. Prasanth Mathew made the claim that students in science classes are essentially becoming mini scientists. Following it, the topic of discussion was the origin of scientists. The second panelist, Mr. Nived, made a comment to the effect that "curiosity is the driving factor that leads to all discoveries". Some of the attendees, though, took issue with that. They claimed that "curiosity" and "necessity" are what lead to discoveries. Finally, they concluded that "necessity" will lead to inventions and "curiosity" will lead to discoveries.

to discoveries. This suggests that there are two categories of scientists: discoverers and inventors. The final panellist, Ms. Anusree, described how scientists come up with tentative or untentative answers to problems through a process that includes observation, hypothesis creation, and either temporary or permanent solutions then to answers.

The first panel discussion day was then finished with the query "What is the scientific methodology?" Ms. Anitta Roy proposed a vote of gratitude at the conclusion of the debate.

Day 2:

The second day of panel discussion was started with a welcome speech by Ms. Drishya P. P. The moderator, Dr. Prasanth Mathew, started the discussion with a question about whether questions, problems, and issues are the same or different on 17th October 2022.

The participants said that, "There are solutions for each problem, but there is no solution for an issue, but sometimes the solutions for issues are responsible actions." Further discussion leads to types of research. There are many types of research, including basic research, applied research, analytical research, quantitative research, qualitative research, etc. However, the main two views are basic research and applied research. In basic research, research is based on fundamental things. Therefore, new theories are developed by scientists from questions. The methodology of basic research is as follows:

Data → patterns → hypothesis

In applied research, the research is based on the theories that have developed from basic research, i.e., scientific truths are used. The methodology of applied research is as follows,

Theories → hypothesis → data → confirmation of theory. This type of research will lead to concepts. Based on these two pieces of data, we can distinguish scientific methods into basic research and applied research. From this, we can say that basic research is based on curiosity, which leads to discoveries, i.e., each scientific truth is a discovery. And in the same way, applied research is based on necessity, which leads to inventions, i.e., each invention are concepts. The next question was, what scientists and philosophers do? Whether both are the same? After discussion on these questions, some of the panellists and participants concluded that scientists use both logical and technical processes, and that it is a hands-on process, i.e., it is an empirical method. And philosophers are those who use logic only. It is a mind-on process, i.e., it is an analytical method. However, some scientists, like Isaac Newton, Aristotle, etc., are also philosophers. Then the discussion went through whether science and technology are interrelated. This leads to the conclusion that both science and technology are related because technology is a continuation of science. In technology, they are using the theories that were discovered through basic research. The further discussion was on six types of thinking, which are: reasoning, concept formation, critical thinking, creative thinking, problem solving, and discussion making.

The discussion concluded with the concept that there are naturalistic observations and artificial observations, i.e., basic research is based on naturalistic observations and applied research is based on artificial observations. At the end of the discussion, a vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Divya K. S.


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Day 3:

Physical science department of PKM College of Education (2022-2024 batch) On October 18, 2022, at 1:30 pm, we held the concluding session of our panel discussion on the subject "Science is what Scientists do" in the physical science classroom. Dr. Prasanth Mathew served as the discussion's moderator (Head of the department of Physical Science).

The moderator made the point that nature and the human mind are structured. What do scientists do? was appropriately addressed by sir. They do investigate the natural world. Then he talked about the three "i"s of nature: interdependence, interrelationships, and interconnections. Then we discussed the need to structure developed knowledge, that is, to organise, analyse, and synthesise it. We then clearly understood that facts are discrete and concepts are broad ideas. Psychological point of conceptualization is viewed via the lenses of sensation, perception, abstraction, and generalisation. Gestalt theory is typically how we understand perception. Through obtaining, organizing, analysing, and synthesising data we will get some insights. The four components of concepts—examples of concepts, attributes of concepts, definitions of concepts, and names—were then the subject of our discussion. The four components of a notion, from a scientific standpoint, are scientific facts, scientific attributes, scientific definition, and scientific name. Then, sir emphasised the point that concepts, laws, theories, and principles are forms of conceptual knowledge. The moderator stated that empirical questions will provide empirical answers through basic research, which will produce scientific data that need to be organized, analysed, and synthesised. Similarly, concepts are formed from analytical answers through applied research. Then, sir discussed the four categories of knowledge: factual, conceptual, procedural, and metacognitive. Then, we talked about the laws, concepts, principles, theories, and facts that are the products of science. By 2.30 pm, the vote of thanks proposed by Ms. Anju T Mathew brought the discussion to a close.

The major outcomes of the three-day panel discussion on "Science Is What Scientists Do" were;

- ❖ The motivation behind inventions is necessity, while the motivation behind discoveries is curiosity.
- ❖ Inventions are built on discoveries.
- ❖ Technology and science are interconnected.
- ❖ Science is continued and applied through technology.
- ❖ Empirical (Hands-on) questions will yield empirical answers through empirical processes (basic research) which will result in scientific facts, and analytical (minds on) questions will yield analytical answers through analytical processes (applied research) which will result in concepts.
- ❖ Basic and applied research are the two categories of research. The basic and applied research rely on the theory's location: i.e., if theory is the foundation, it is applied research and if theory lies the last it is basic research.
- ❖ Facts are real and discrete while concepts are broad ideas.
- ❖ Empirical questions arise from observation and analytical questions via thinking process.
- ❖ Four components of scientific concepts are scientific facts, scientific attributes, scientific definitions, and scientific name.




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- ◆ The scientific facts obtained should be organized, analysed, and synthesized.
- ◆ Facts, theories, principles, laws, and concepts are the product of science.

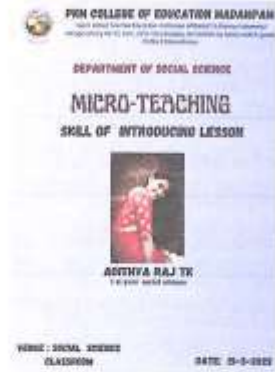

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MICRO TEACHING REPORT

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EPOSTER MAKING

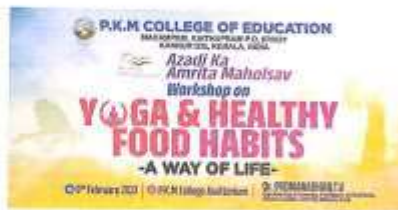
