Data Analysis

School Environment

GHS Mamalakkandam is in Ernakulam district and belong to the Kothamangalam subdistrict. Due to geographical characteristics there are only 74 children in the school who mostly living nearby. The school has a bus which is a necessary as the students has to walk for kilometers to reach to the school. The school is situated in a lush green environment and surrounded by hills.

School Infrastructure

Established in the year 1983, the school started as an upper primary school. In 2000, it got upgraded as a high school. Currently the school has three concrete buildings that comprises of nine classrooms, an office cum staffroom and a meal preparation room. Out of these five are smart classrooms. There is a compound wall and a small school ground. From the well situated near to the office all the needs are met. Two separate toilet buildings for girls and boys are there.

School Dynamics

School working hour is from 10.30 am to 3:30 pm. At 9:45 am the teachers will gather in the office and plan the day. The classes will start after the general prayer at 10 am. The assembly meets every Monday. The 15 to 20 minute assembly consists of prayer, pledge, thought of the day, main events, teacher's speech, national anthem, etc. There are 8 periods of 40 minutes. There is an interval of 10 minutes after two periods in the morning and two periods in the afternoon. Lunch break is 45 minutes. Sports, arts, work experience etc. are also included in the timetable. At 3:30 pm school dismiss with national anthem. Due to geographical constraints, there is limitations in the time available at school.

Teachers and Activities

There are 10 teachers working in GHS Mamalakkandam. Seminars, courses, meetings, conferences, workshops etc. are conducted for them as part of enhancing professional

competence. They are hardworking and dedicated teachers although they have limitations due to various factors.

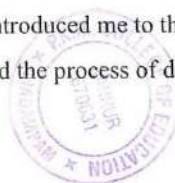
Teaching Learning Process

From 30/01/23 to 03/02/23 I was able to observe classes of teachers in different classes. It is a fact that Covid pandemic has hit this area very badly especially school education and as a result, some of the students face difficulty in reading and writing. Thus, the teachers try to classify the students and give them care and support accordingly. A special programme called Sradha is organised for backward students. 11 students are beneficiaries of this special training on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Even though lab facilities are not available for science classes, the teachers make use of the maximum available resources. A well-structured and equipped IT lab provides maximum support for students in mastering IT.

Day wise Report

Day 1, 30/01/2023

I reached the school before time and met the HM Siji Mathew teacher and handed over the letter from the college. She took me to the school premises and explained the structure and available facilities at the school. At sharp 11 am one minute silence was observed as it is the Martyrs Day. During the first interval, she introduced me to the other teachers and staff. After the interval visited the library and understood the process of digitization of the school library.

Day 2, 31/01/2023

An assembly was conducted in order to give necessary instructions and facilitate a student in the morning. I could understand the procedure of an assembly and how the teachers organize an assembly with the help of students of the concerned class. In the afternoon I accompanied the English teacher for the previous question paper discussion for the 10th class students. At 2.30 pm an awareness class was organized by the excise department and I could listen to the class along with high school students.

Day 3, 01/02/2023

Everyday morning, the assigned students water the newly planted herbs and trees in the biodiversity park. I went there in the morning and helped the students to water the plants. HM clarified many of my doubts regarding appointment, experience and rules regarding the selection of guest teachers at school. I also made an attempt to observe the activities in the office. I could observe the Mathematics class of Mr. Anish who is an experienced teacher in the afternoon.


Day 4, 02/02/2023

As the teacher was on leave, I was assigned to got to the sradha class in the morning. The students were not able to write properly the basic details about them and I could help them and gave necessary corrections. After the Sradha class, I could also do the remaining library digitization work. In the afternoon, I observed the class taken by Mr. Arun for the class 8 students. His class was really engaging which was about waste management.

Day 5, 03/02/2023

As it was the last day of my school acclimatization I completed the work of library digitization and I am very proud to say that I could enter the details of more than 40 books in two days. I could also observe the science class taken by Niji teacher which was very helpful in understanding nature of science classes. There was a brief sent off programme in the lunch arranged for me and the HM presented me with the programme completion certificate. I could also meet the tribal department officers who came for a visit at the school.

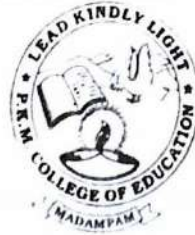

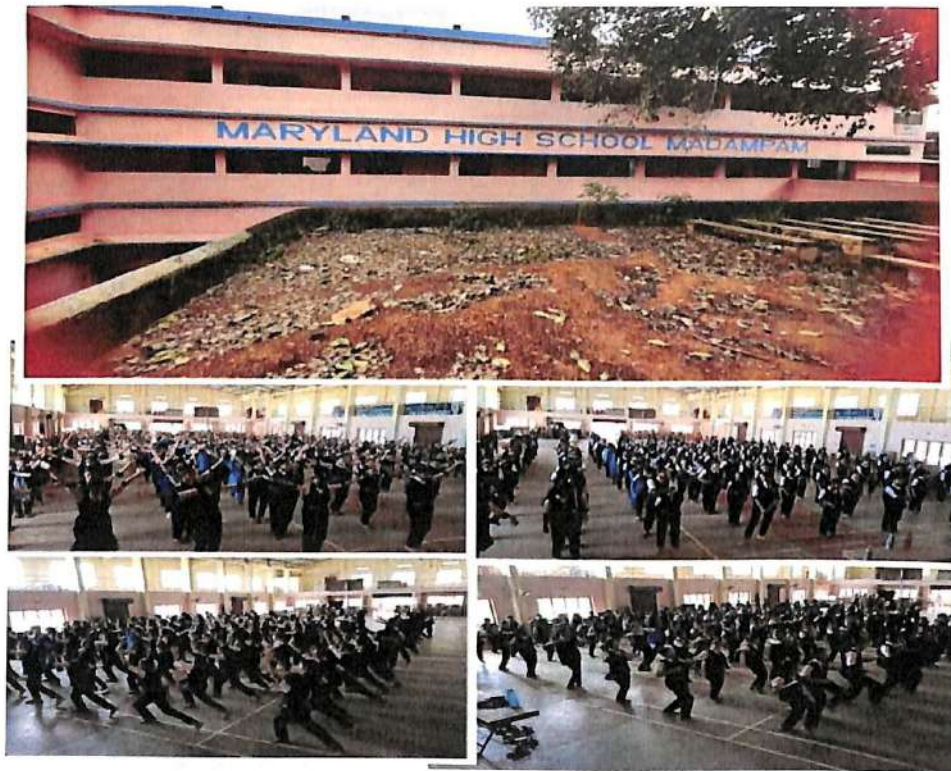

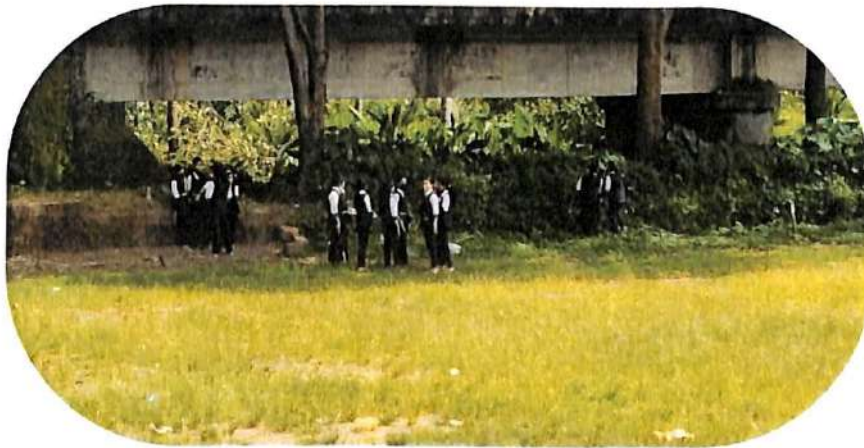
DAY 4

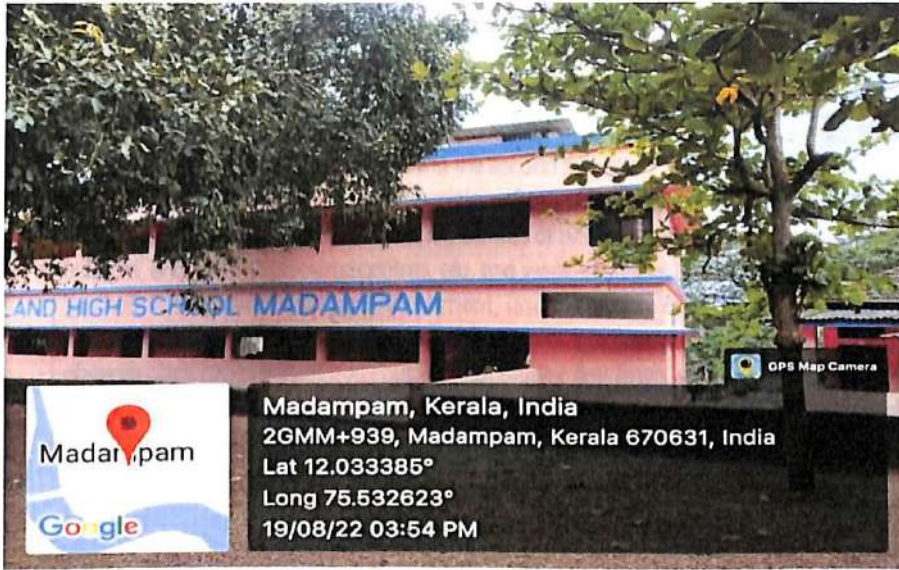

General Information About the School

Madampam Maryland High School was established in 1945. This is a government aided school. The name of the head teacher is Binoy K. A total of 49 teachers are working in the school. There are 24 female teachers and 25 male teachers. Four non-teaching staff work here. The total number of children is 1450 out of which 676 are girls and 774 are boys.

2. School premises

The school is located in a rural area. 14 shade trees are there in the school compound. Three buses and three school vans are currently operating for transportation. Apart from these other private vehicles and people are used for school transportation. The approximate distance between the school and the road is one meter. A wall separates the school from the road. The only source of fresh water is the well. There is only a waste pit to avoid waste

3. School resources

The school building is mostly made of concrete. However asbestos and roofing sheet ,oat are also used as roofs. There are buildings with age 45,40,38,12,6,5,4,1. There are 54 classrooms in this school. This school has full 40 divisions consisting of four divisions in each class. The materials available in the classroom are bench and desk ,chair, fan, light, table waste box and board LCD projector. The school has English medium divisions and the ratio is 27 [english medium] 13 [malayalam medium]. There are urinal facilities in four buildings for boys and girls. Out of these One for girls and two for boys. There are 2 toilets for teachers next to the staff room. Internet facility is available in the school. And LCD projectors [18] and computers [41] are also available here for the students. The school has a science lab and a computer lab[2]. The library is active every Thursday. There is also an IED classroom for special children. A common informational instructional system is in place to provide instruction to children. There is no store facility in the school compound.

School activities start at 10 am. The Assembly shall not meet every day. About 45 minutes are spent on assembly. Prayer, Headmaster's instructions, National Anthem

8 periods are allowed in the school. The first two periods are 45 minutes long, the next two periods are 40 minutes long and the subsequent periods are 35 minutes long. The duration of breaks given to children is 10 minutes. 45 minutes are given for lunch. Sports training and art training are available in this timetable.

INTRODUCTION


A Teacher plays a major role in the functioning of a school. Other than taking classes and helping the learners to acquire knowledge, a teacher engages in various tasks. The two- year Bed course therefore includes a one week school acclimatization programme for student teachers. During this period, prospective teachers shall observe class room transactions but will not deliver any lessons. The main objective of the school acclimatization programme is to acclimatize student teachers to the **school and its environment, understanding of children, teaching learning process and school dynamics.**

Physical environment of the school is a key factor in the education process taking place in that school since the learners constantly interact with it consciously or unconsciously. So, it is very important for the student teachers to get to know more about this factor. Understanding children is another major dimension of the school acclimatization programme. The whole teaching learning process depends upon the behavior of the learners. It would be better if the student teachers get an idea about the behavior of the learners which would help them for preparing their internship. Teaching learning process and school dynamics also play a major role in the overall functioning of the school. A teacher needs to be aware of all these four dimensions. Thus, the school acclimatization helps the student teachers to develop an idea about school atmosphere and nature of the learners before teaching practice.

METHODOLOGY

The data collection is based on both primary and secondary data. Primary data is collected through oral discussions and face to face interview. Data is actually collected through the direct interview method with the use of structured questionnaire. Secondary data is collected through the secondary sources like official records (registers), school website etc. The method of observation is used to observe various infrastructural facilities available in the school, school environment, school activities, teaching learning process and school dynamics.


TOOLS

- 1) A checklist was designed to analyze the school infrastructure and it's environment .
- 2) A questionnaire was designed to understand children and teaching learning process.
- 3) An observation schedule is made to analyze the teaching learning process.

ACTION PLAN

- ❖ Second day was utilized to observe the classes of teachers and also observe the behavior characteristics of children.
- ❖ The third day was utilized to participate in the Independence Day programme of the school
- ❖ Fourth day was utilized to understand the school activities. Using interview method, details are collected from the teachers about the teaching learning process and school dynamics.
- ❖ Fifth was utilized to engage the various classes and also understand the children's attitude, characteristics, academic Interests and so on.
- ❖ Sixth day was utilized to collect the details from teachers regarding student's social service organizations, school achievements, creativity oriented programs , days of observance etc.

DATA GATHERING

CLASS OBSERVATION (12-08-2022 to 19-08-2022)

As per the instruction of Head Master, we approached the respective subjects in charge. We observed classes of three different teachers of our respective subject and also we observed the classes of other subject teachers. More focus was given on observing the kind of teaching aids used by teachers, method of teaching, time management, teacher-pupil interactions and students response.


CLASS ENGAGE

As per the instruction of the Head master, from 11th August 2022 to 17th August 2022, we had the opportunity to engage with children of classes 6th to 9th. We went to the classes during the allotted periods and after getting to know each other we gave the students an opportunity to showcase their talents. Then, we played games like word scramble, End word game, Dumb charades, Memory game, Maths trick with the students. Most of the students actively participated in all the activities. Through this we were able to understand how to manage children of different classes and also it was a great opportunity to observe the differences in behavior and attitude of students at different levels.

PARTICIPATION AND OBSERVATION OF SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

In Iritty Higher Secondary School, morning assembly is not conducted on every day. Usually assembly is conducted on Tuesday, Friday and on other important days. The student

DATA ANALYSIS

SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

Iritty Higher Secondary School, P O Keezhur is a leading school in this locality. It is an aided school which was established in the year 1956. The school is located in a rural area at sufficient distance from the road side. The school building is more than 60 years old with both concrete roofs and clay tile roofs. There are many trees grown around the school environment and the school is separated from the road by a wall around it. High school and Higher Secondary blocks are found within the same compound.

Mr. Babu Mepat is the headmaster of Iritty HSS. Presently there are 42 teachers in the High school session. 952 students are studying in this school which includes 450 boys and 502 girls. There are 32 classrooms with maximum 8 divisions. The school is facilitated with 15 smart class rooms. English and Malayalam medium classes are available here. Facilities like LCD projectors ensure the high tech classrooms. There is enough number of toilets for both boys and girls. All classrooms are made neat and clean to provide good learning environment. The students are cooperative in cleaning the class rooms daily and school environment weekly.

There is a well-equipped IT lab with 36 laptops. Even though the school Library is not fully facilitated, it is available for students according to their needs. Pure water facilities ensure through well. The transport facilities are available in this school for both students and teachers. For proper transportation two school buses are available. Students in the SPC, Red cross, Scout and guide are actively engaging in various activities as per the direction of the teachers. Classroom extension works and day observance are executed through various club activities. The school provides more attention to the IED students. Classes are conducted for them by the special teacher three times in a week. There is a playground found near to the school which engages the students in outdoor activities.

UNDERSTANDING CHILDREN


While observing the behavior of the children most of them are disciplined and follows the rules in the institution. We found rebellious attitude and anger management issues in some learners. The COVID 19 Pandemic and the resulted lockdown had a huge influence in the learners. They became more restless and some of them didn't have the basic subject knowledge. While observing the learners it is found that the two years of online classes were not so effective for them. They face difficulty while learning new concepts since they lack the basic knowledge. In the leisure time most of the children chose to play in the school ground. It is also found that the peer interaction among the learners also has a huge influence on the character development of the children.

TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS

The classes observed by the student teachers are three English classes, one Malayalam class, two Mathematics Classes, four Biology classes and four Social Science classes. In English and Malayalam classes mostly usual lecture method is taking place, but it is interesting because of poems and stories. The English class starts with a real life example and in both classes students are actively responding to the teacher.

The teaching method considered by teacher while teaching Basic Science in UP classes are interesting. The interaction between teacher and students are really good. Teacher uses different teaching aids and also show experiments based on the topic that invoke curiosity in students and also provide first-hand experience to them. The Biology classes in HS start with question answer section. At the end of the classes teachers provides follow up activities related to what have been taught.

The teaching method used in one of the social classes is highly good and a learner centered classroom was developed there. All the students are very active and teacher gave all kind of activities like group activities, discussions that are very useful for the students.

The Maths class which was observed in UP section is a normal kind of class which mainly focused on lecture method but the class was good, students are active and the main teaching aid there was blackboard. But the Maths class observed in HS that is in the 10th standard was outstanding. The teacher used all kinds of teaching aids for the better understanding of the students. The teacher had his own applet for teaching Maths which is very useful for the students.

There is a Special teacher for IED students. The teacher is available for 3 days in a week. The student teachers also got an opportunity to interact with the teacher. She gives good advice and solution to the problem, that is very useful for the students who are unable to give proper attention in studies due to different problems.


It is felt that the classroom management is one of the difficult task for a teacher. We should give equal attention to all the students. Another difficulty is lack of proper teaching aid mainly the use of ICT in all the subjects. The main reason for this is the lack of time for teachers for completing the portions.

SCHOOL DYNAMICS

The school starts at 9.30 am with a prayer. Assembly was conducted at Tuesday, Friday and at any special occasions. There are 7 periods with the duration of 45 minutes. The school timing is up to 3-45 pm. All types of records are available in the office and most of them are dealt by the clerks. The school provides mid day meal to all the students during the lunch break. The meals are prepared in the *kanjipura*.

Different clubs are actively functioning in the school which provides more exposure to the students. Those clubs are social science club, science club, Maths club. The school also have good achievements in arts and sports in different levels. The different student's social service organizations are functioning in the school like NCC, Scout and guides, JRC and SPC .

Generally, the acclimatization programme is a stepping stone before the training period in school. It is an effective way to understand and comprehend the school environment internally and externally.




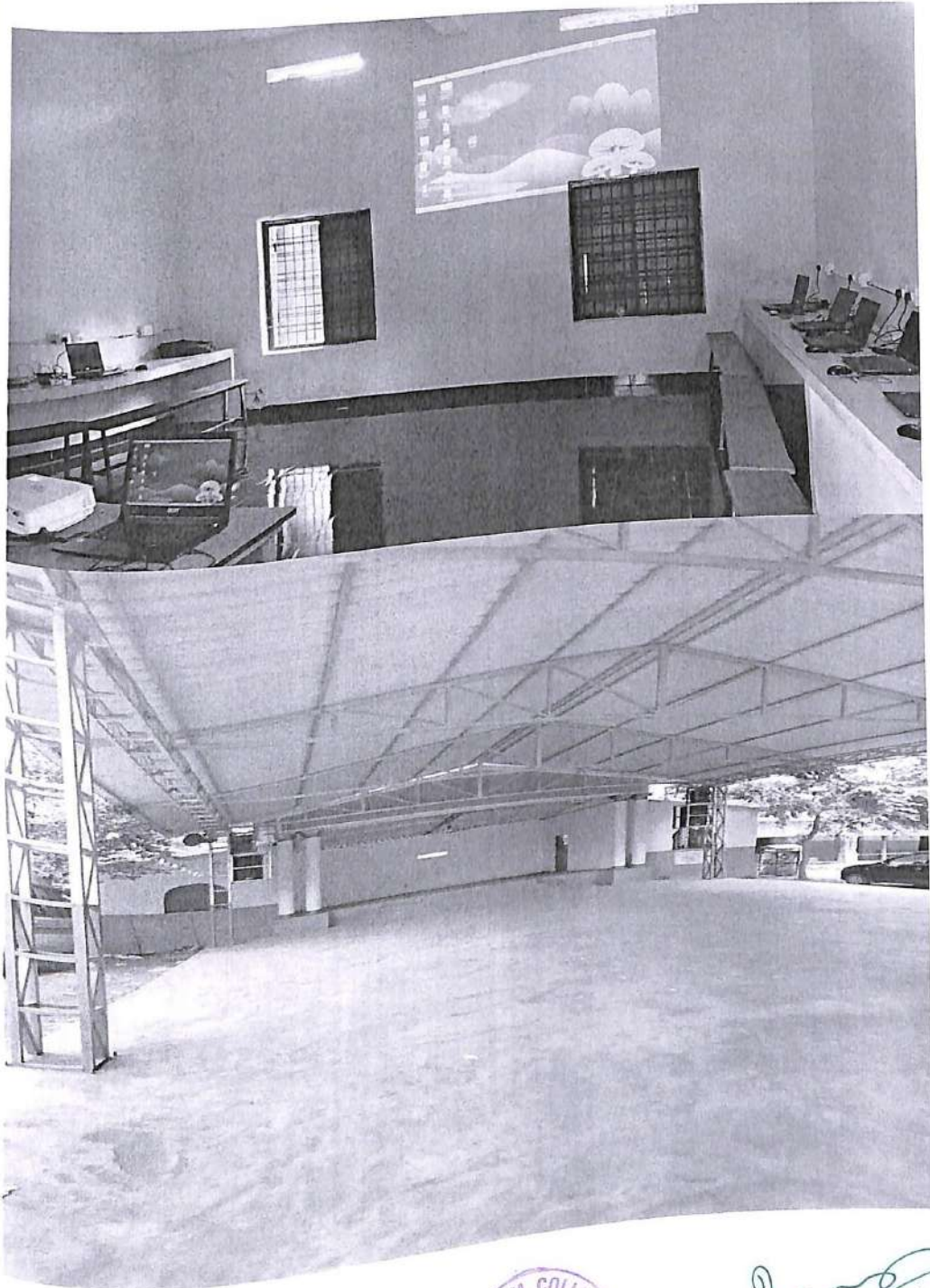

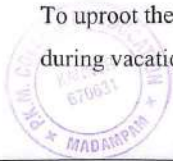
SCHOOL DYNAMICS

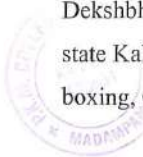

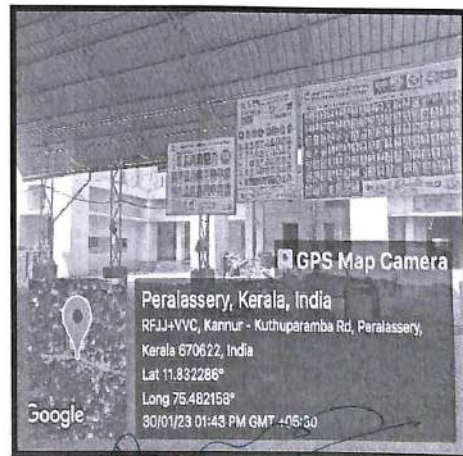

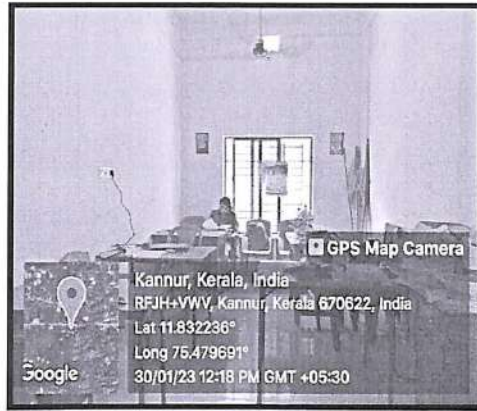
Day 1 – 30/01/2023, Monday.

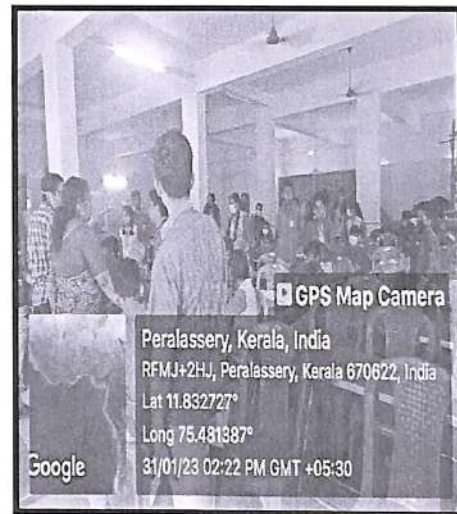
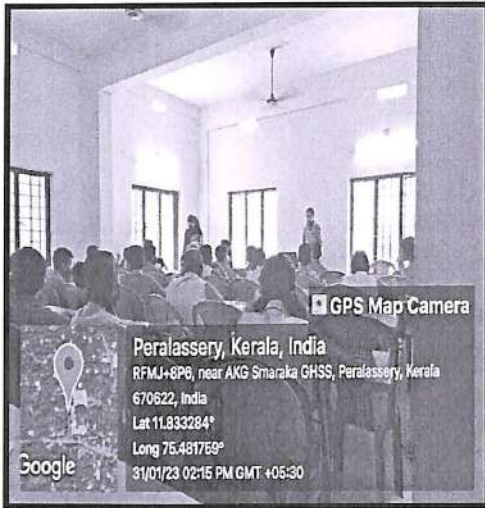
Day 2 – 31/1/2023, Tuesday

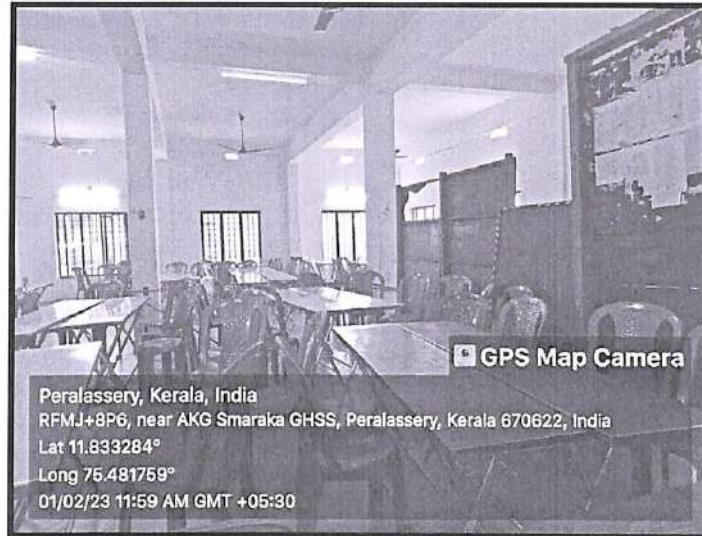


Day 3 – 1/02/2023, Wednesday
