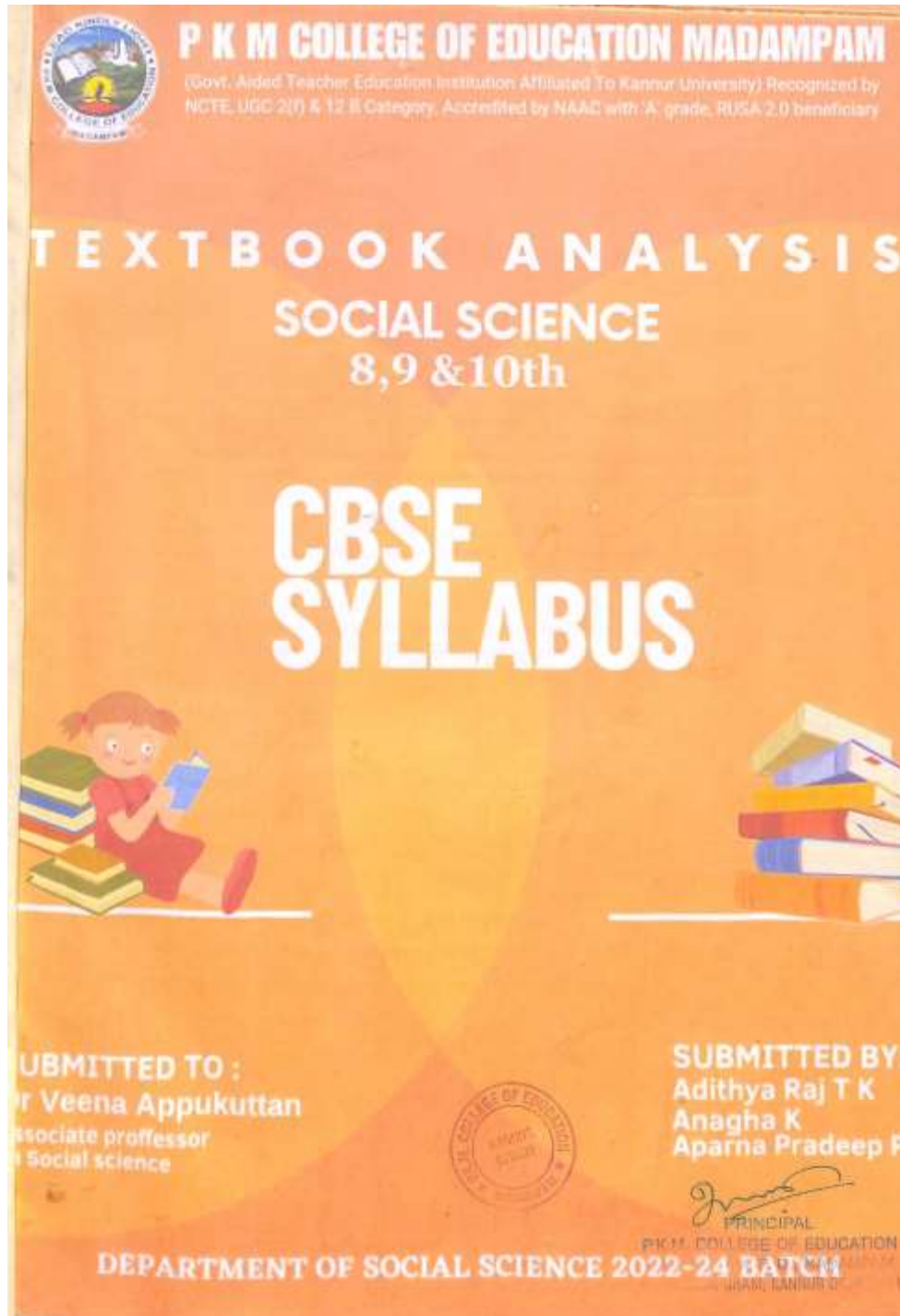

In textbook analysis we check that the textbook is attractive or not which language is used in vocabulary, docs the language is appropriate for the student.



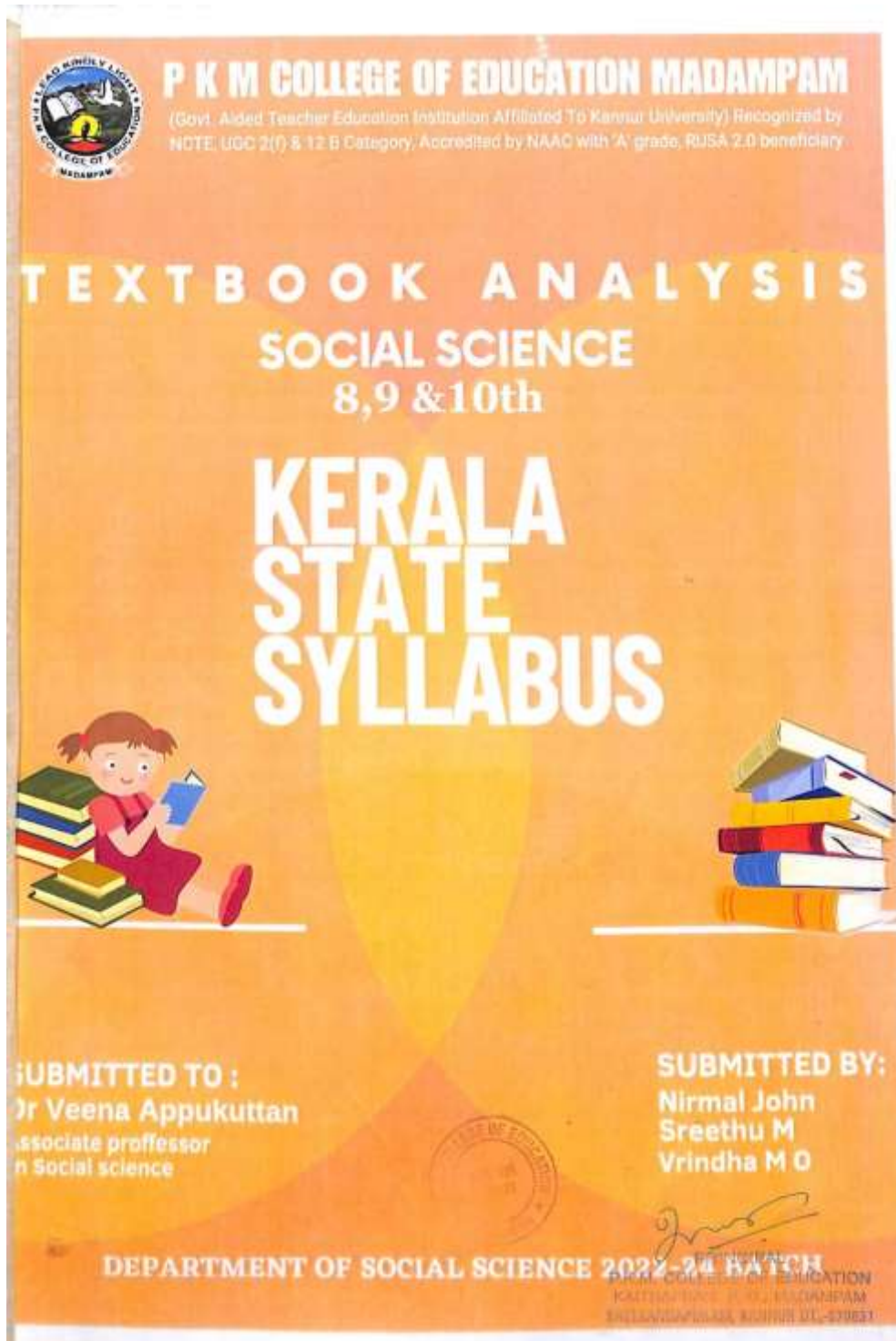
