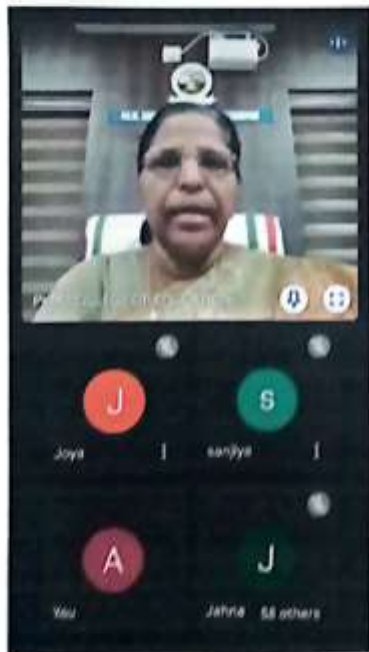
Chalanam – Reading Day Observance 2022
