#### Introduction

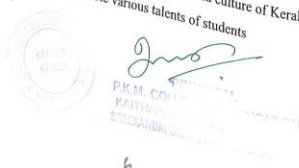

This event was helpful to satisfy the objectives of the sports day to some extent. Also, the event was helpful to encourage the students and recognize their real potential.

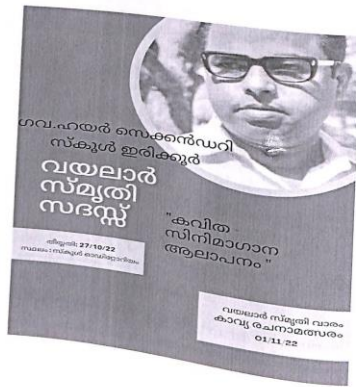

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**Evaluation**

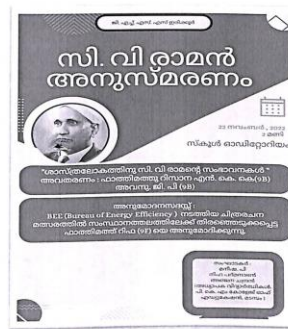

#### Planning


