TREKKING WAS ORGANIZED IN RANIPURAM, ALSO KNOWN AS OOTY IN KERALA.

A trekking program was organized on Saturday, March 26, 2022 under the joint auspices of Physical Education Department and Health Fitness Club of PKM College of Education. Under the leadership of Physical Education Department Head Sinoj Joseph, 44 teaching students and 1 office staff participated in the trekking. Ranipuram is a tourist destination located in Panathadi Panchayat of Kasaragod district in Kerala. The settlers named this place as Ranipuram in memory of Saint Mary. Ranipuram peak is located at an altitude of 1048 meters above sea level in the Coorg hills. Ranipuram is 48 km east of Kanhangad on the Panathur road, 9 km away from Panathadi. Except for the three children who had difficulty in traveling, all the others reached the hill top. There is a five kilometer trekking path to the hills and back. It started at 10:30 and by exactly 1:30 everyone came down the mountain. Food was prepared at Sinoj sir's house at 2:30. After the meal, the teacher visited Marisa's house and returned at exactly 4:30. On the way Visited Chuttad beach at Puyyangadi seashore located between Payyannur and Pazhyangadi. Its densely populated fan trees are also a haven for many birds. After reaching the beach at 6 o'clock and spending around 30 minutes at the beach, the bus returned at exactly 7 o'clock and reached the bus college stop at 9 o'clock.

Post Covid fitness training programme

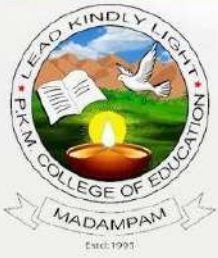


