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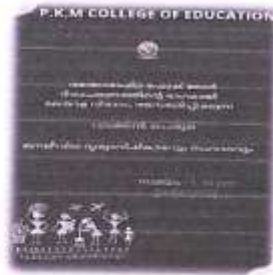

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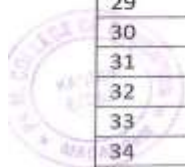

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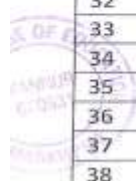

The Peace Forum at PKM College of Education and IQAC in association with Peace and Harmony Foundation, Kannur conducted an International Webinar on the topic, 'Non-violence: A Developmental Pillar for Human Race' on the 14<sup>th</sup> of August via Zoom. The webinar saw the participation of over 50 people from various walks of life such as students, teacher-trainers, teachers and activists.


