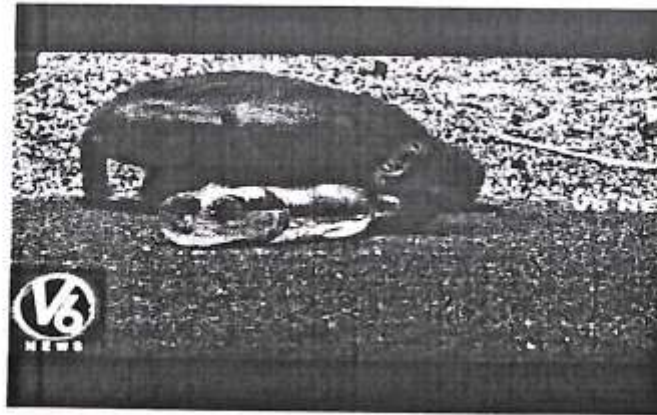

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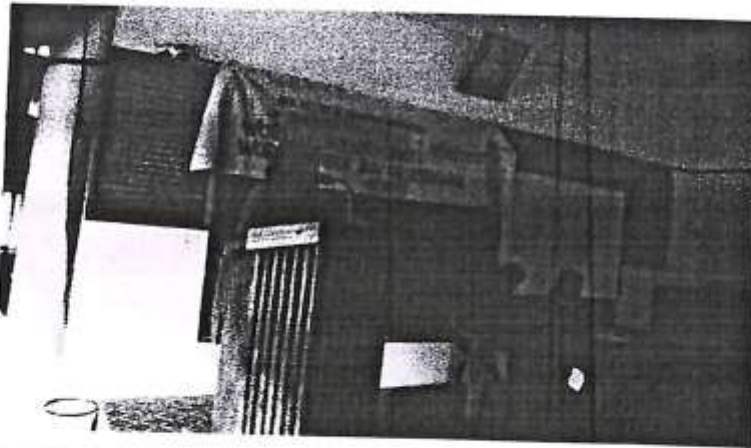



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TECHNICAL SESSION

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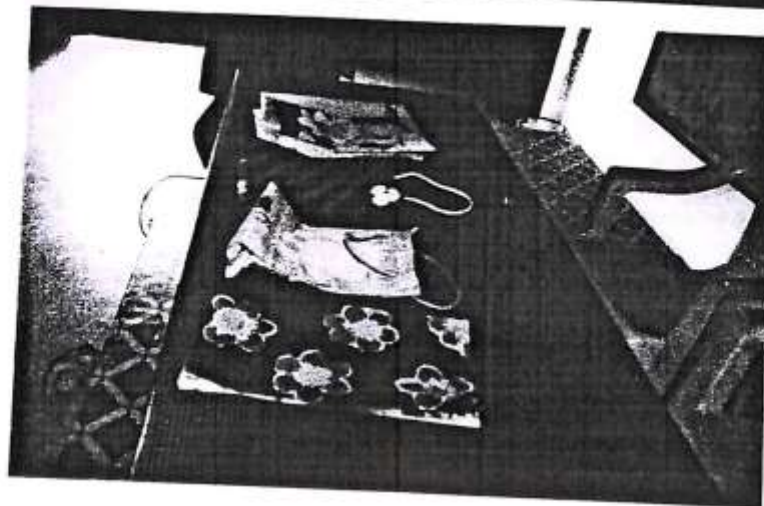
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REUSE WORKSHOP

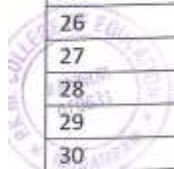

TECHNICAL SESSION


The technical session began at 10.30AM by the welcome speech of Shebin KRaju, student coordinator of mathematics department.

Seminar was on the topic "Mathematical Applications In Atmospheric Science" by Prof K V George. First he introduced about Srinivasa Ramanujan and his contributions in mathematics. He explained Fibonacci series and its magical influence in nature. Later he discussed many interesting natural phenomenonssuch asBig Bang Theory and climate variations etc.

He described about the occurrence of different seasons and in India. The tropical year is divided into four astronomical seasons. In the north the astronomical seasons Spring, Summer, Autumn and winterbegins when the sun comes to march equinox June solstice, September equinox and December solsticc respectively.

The most attractive part of the seminar was the history of astrology. In olden days, the sky was mapped out to imaginary pictures and each group of stars forming one of these pictures was called constellation. There are altogether 88 constellation.the name of many constellations are animal mythological characters occupations etc.Each Zodie sign contains a constellation and it is named after the imaginary figure it resembles.We all understood how horoscope of a child is made and how it is related to these constellations, called Zodial constellations.

This sequence is seen in smallest nautilus, the number of petals found in a flower, palm fruit bunches, tree branches and even in the shape of the largest galaxy's. The sequence is also directly connected with the Golden Ratio and is used throughout history in many heavenly works such as Great Pyramid of Giza, TajMahal, the painting Mona Lisa etc.

FEEDBACK SESSION

Feedback session of National Mathematics Day celebration was conducted soon after the programme. A questionnaire consisting of three questions was given to all participants. The questions were

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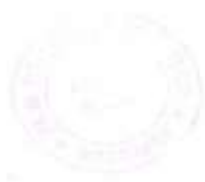
Name of the Programme: Science for All Generations

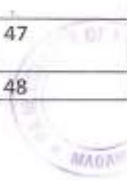

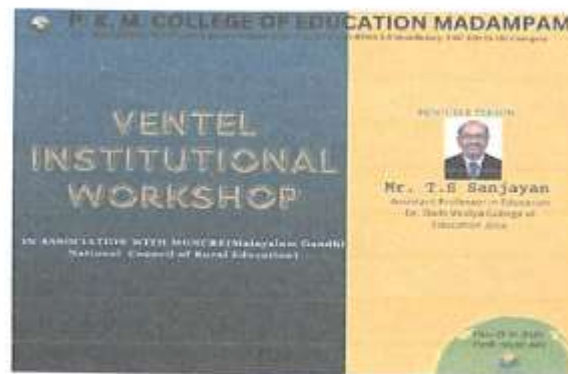

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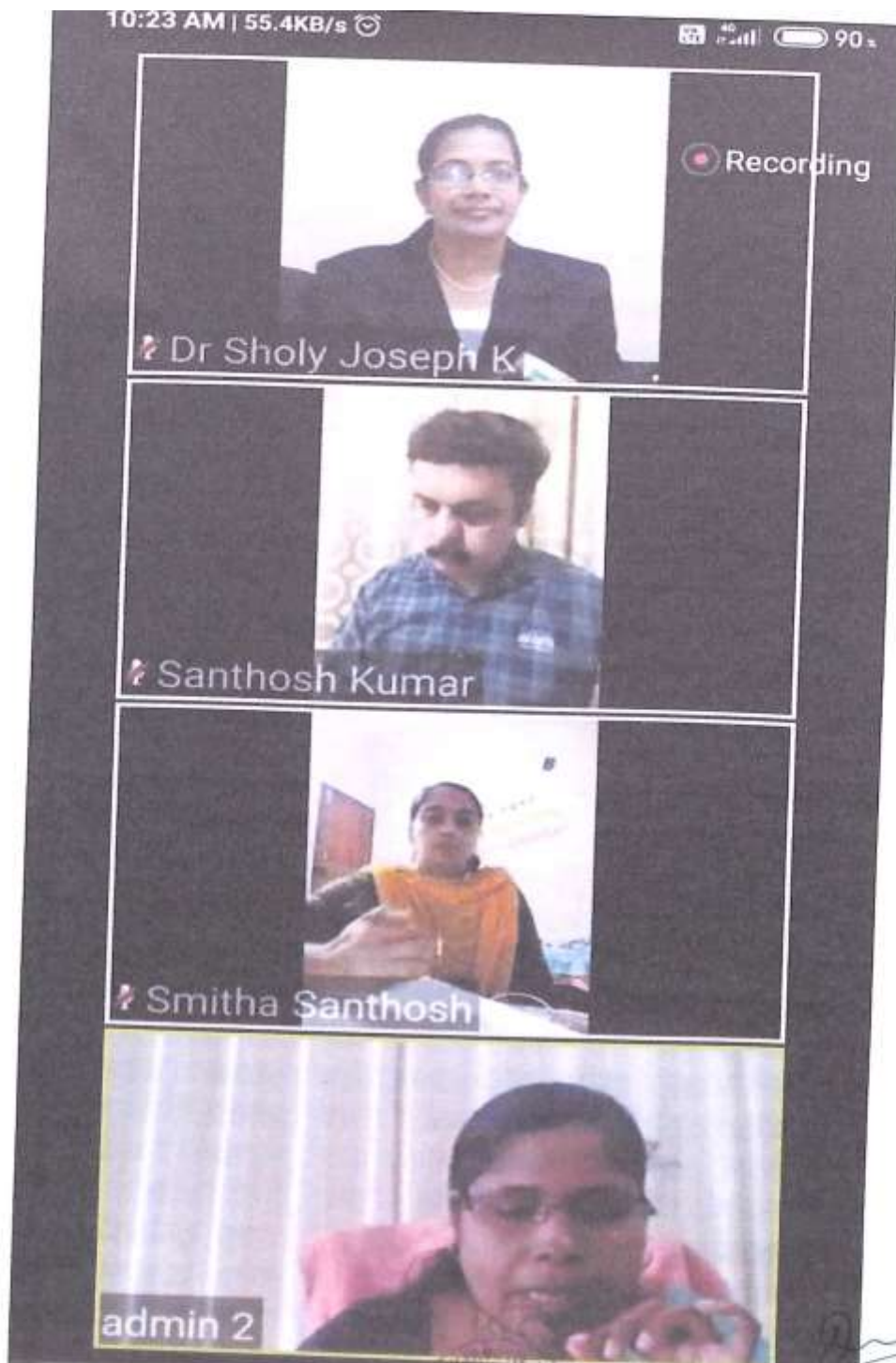
