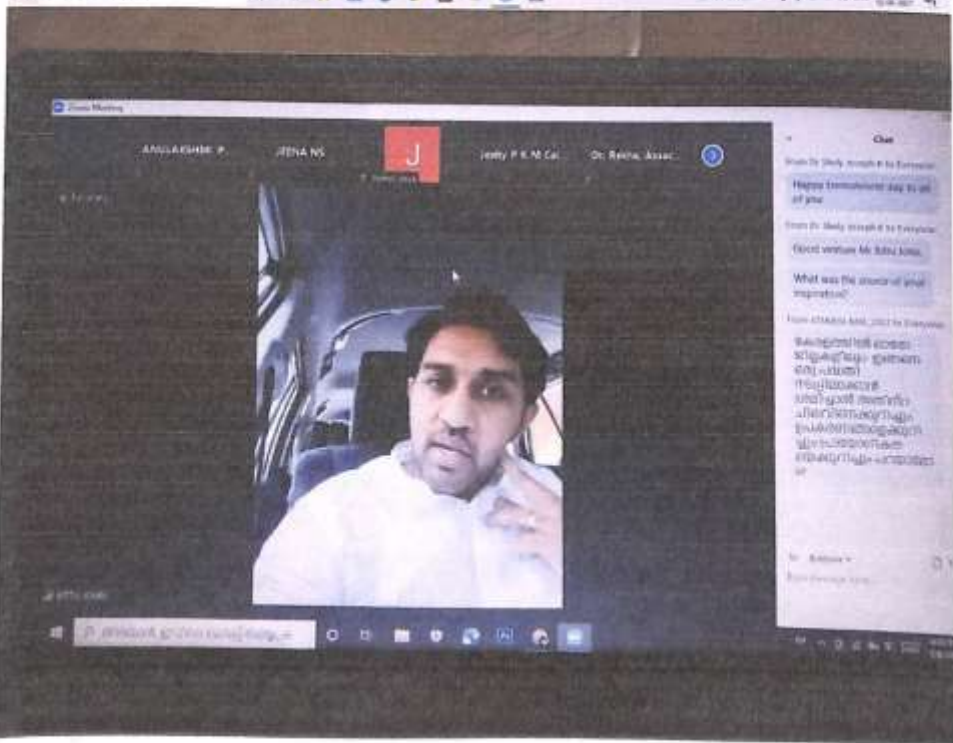
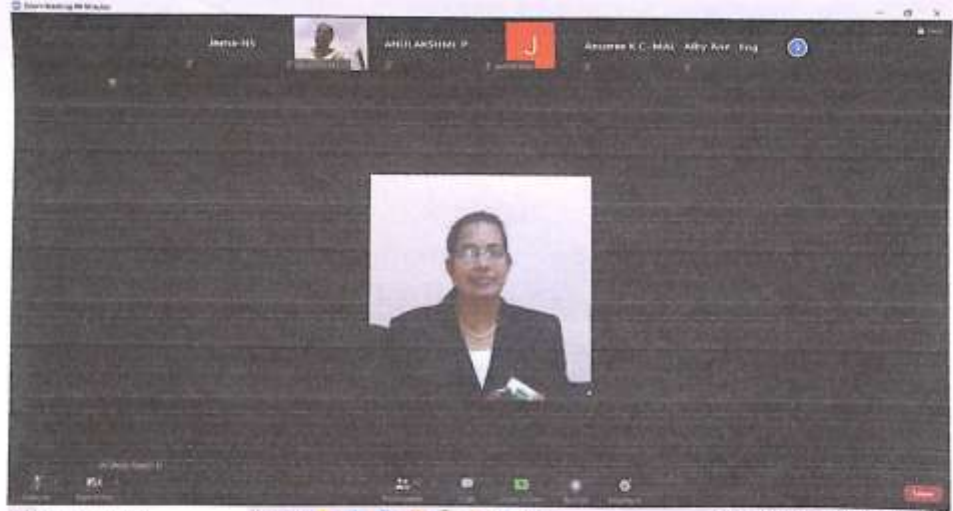
### 4. ONLINE ENVIRONMENT QUIZ
