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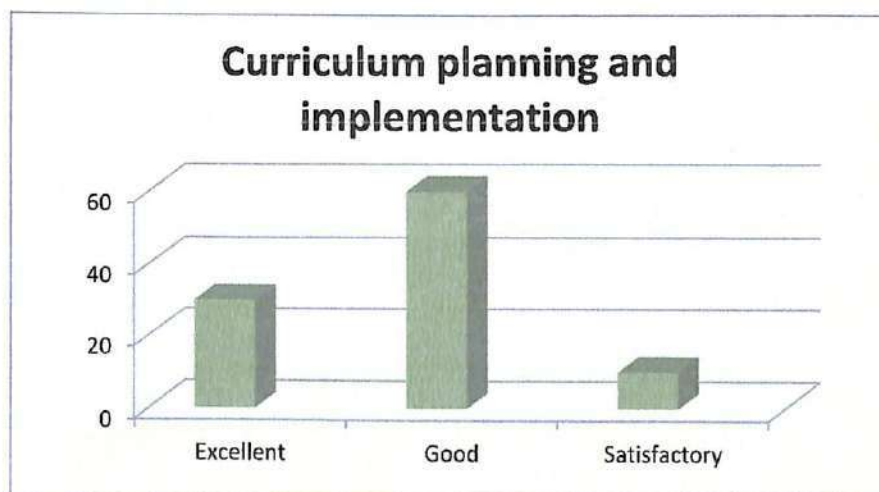
## REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION FROM ALUMNI

#### 1. Collaborative effort of the institution in curriculum planning and implementation (in %)

30% of respondents responded that the curriculum planning and implementation is excellent. 60% of respondents responded that the curriculum planning and implementation is good. 10% respondents responded that curriculum planning and implementation is satisfactory.

Curricular attainment of objectives and learning outcomes	70%	10%	20%



  
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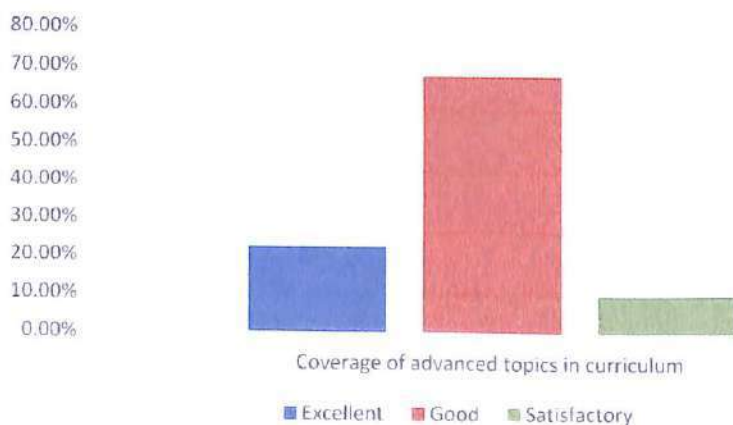
### Curricular attainment of objectives and learning outcomes

Coverage of advanced topics in curriculum	22.5%	67.5%	10%





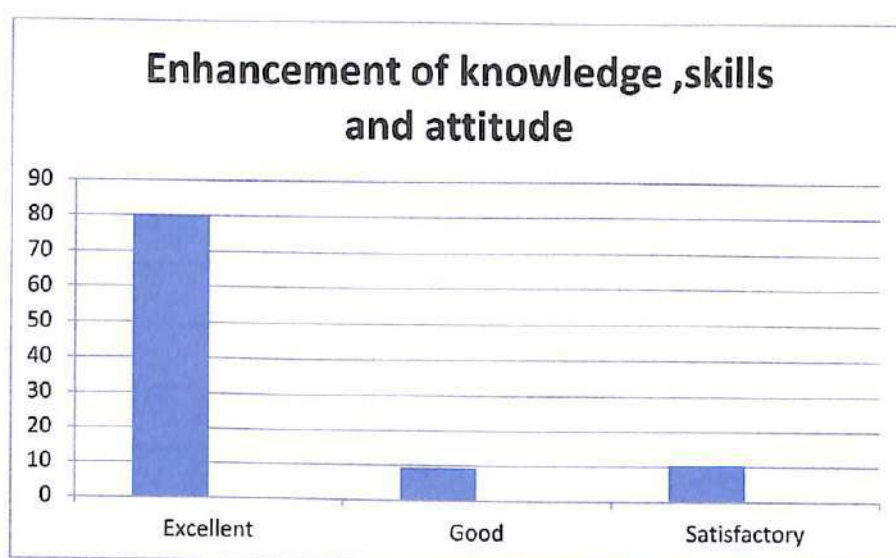

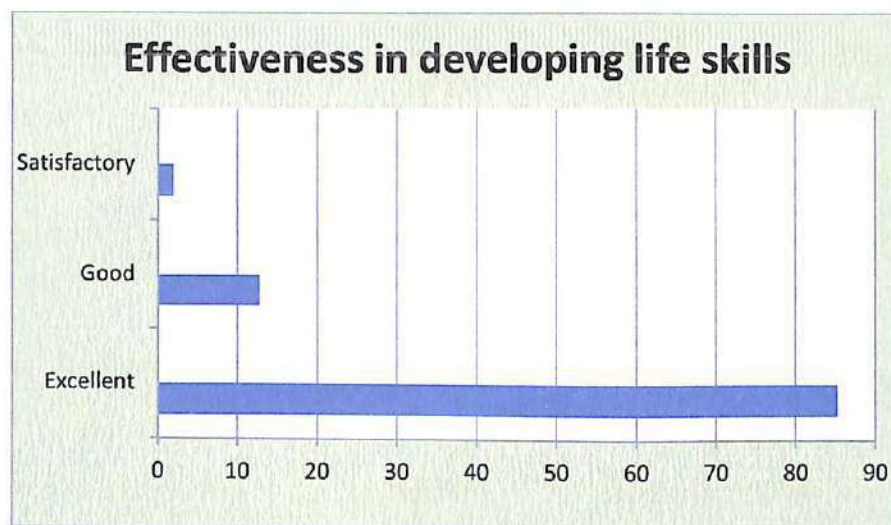
#### 5. Effectiveness in developing life skills (in %)

Effectiveness in developing life skills	85.25%	12.75%	2%



  
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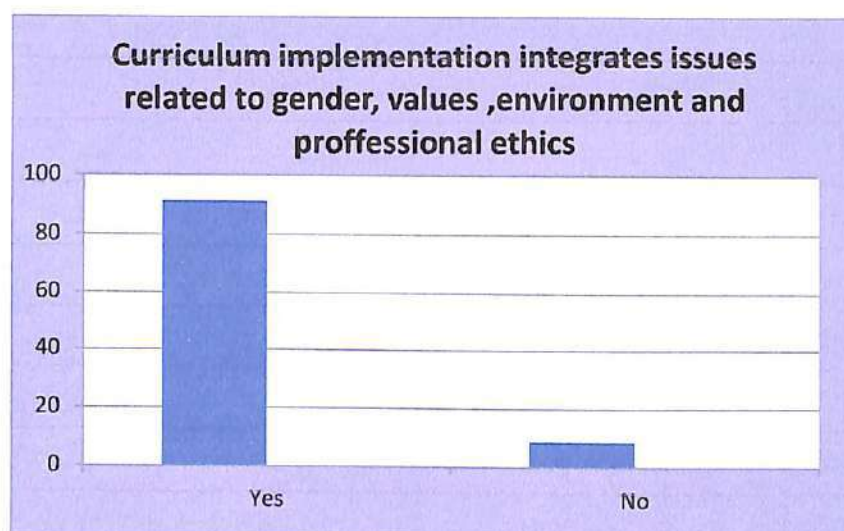

Integrates issues relevant to gender, values, environment and professional ethics	91.25%	8.75%



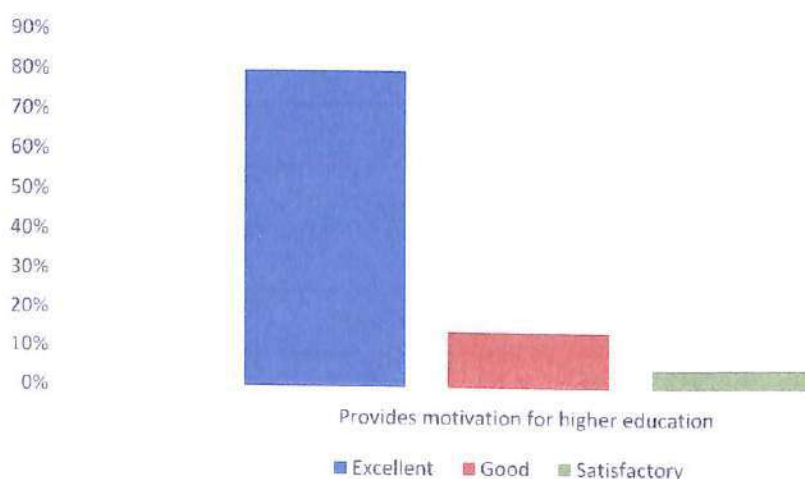

Provides motivation for higher education	80%	14.75%	5.25%



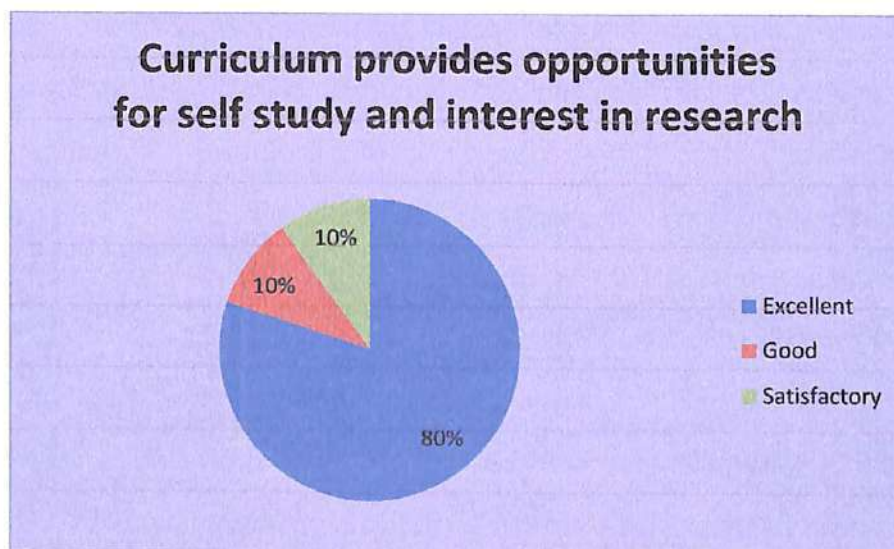

### FINDINGS

- Most of the respondents says that the collaborative effort of the institution in curriculum planning and implementation is good.
- Majority of the respondents have the opinion that curricular attainment of objectives and learning outcomes are excellent.
- Majority have the opinion that there is a good coverage of advanced topics in curriculum.
- Majority have the opinion that there is an excellent enhancement of knowledge, skills and attitudes.
- Majority says that there is an excellent effectiveness in developing life skills.
- Most of the respondents have an opinion that Curriculum implementation integrates issues relevant to gender, values, environment and professional ethics.
- Majority of the respondents have an opinion that curriculum enrichment process provides motivation for higher education.
- Most of the respondents have an opinion that curriculum provides opportunities for self study and for interest in research.
- Almost all respondents says that curriculum met their employability expectations.

### AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT:

- While a good percentage of respondents believe that there is a good coverage of advanced topics in the curriculum, there is still room for improvement. Consider identifying areas where more advanced topics can be integrated to enhance the depth of knowledge.



  
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- Although the majority of respondents feel that there is an excellent enhancement of knowledge, skills, and attitudes, there is still a small percentage who find it satisfactory. Explore ways to bridge this gap and ensure a more uniform positive response.
- The integration of issues relevant to gender, values, environment, and professional ethics is well-received by the majority, but there is still a small percentage who feel it is lacking. Evaluate and address specific areas where these issues can be further integrated into the curriculum.
- The curriculum enrichment process, while providing good motivation for higher education according to most respondents, can still be improved to increase satisfaction levels.
- While the curriculum provides opportunities for self-study and interest in research, there is a small percentage finding it only satisfactory. Consider ways to enhance these opportunities to meet the expectations of all alumni.
