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REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION FROM ALUMNI

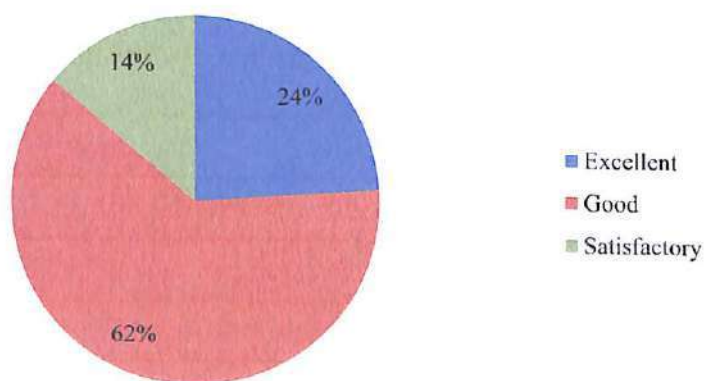
ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21

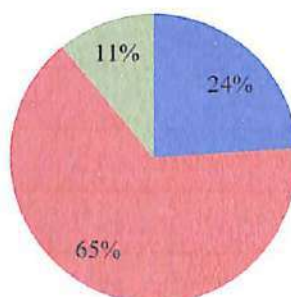

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2. Curricular attainment of objectives and learning outcome.

3. Coverage of advanced topics in curriculum.

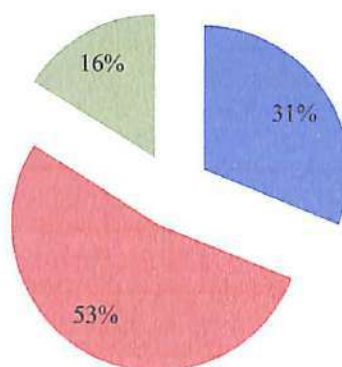

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Development of life skills

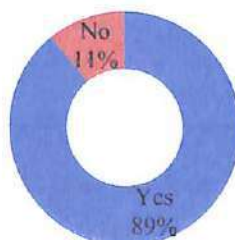

Integration of various issues





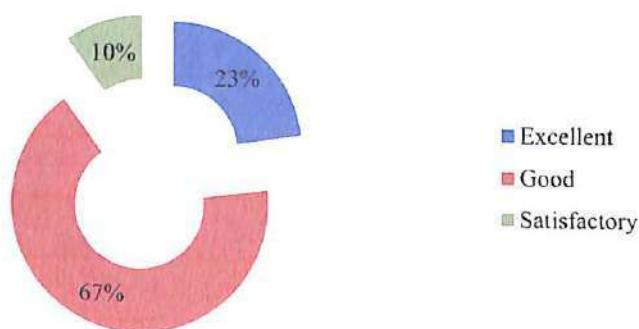

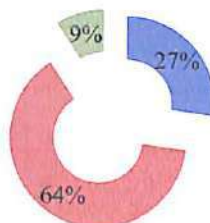



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Self-study and interest in research

■ Excellent ■ Good ■ Satisfactory



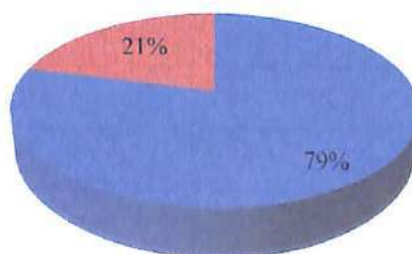
