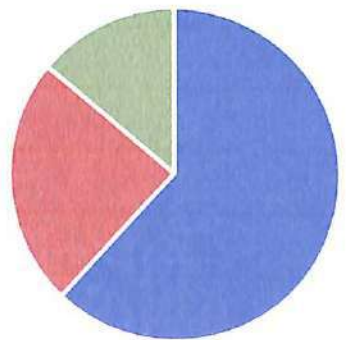
REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTION FROM ALUMNI

■ Excellent ■ Good ■ Satisfactory

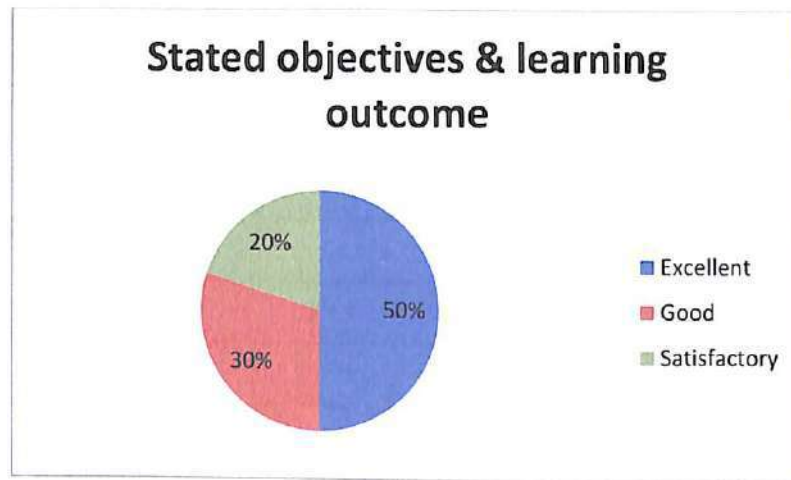

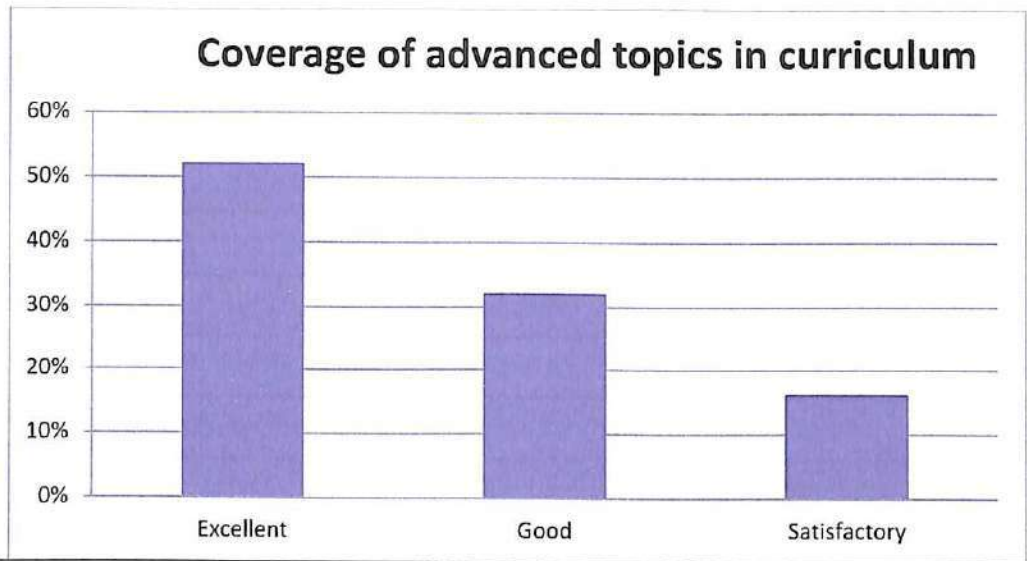
3. Coverage of advanced topics in curriculum.

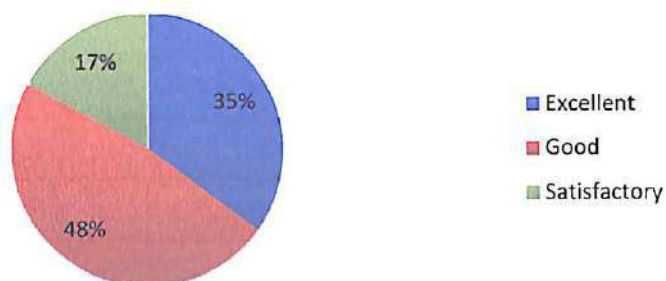
Enhancement of knowledge, skills and attitude in curriculum.

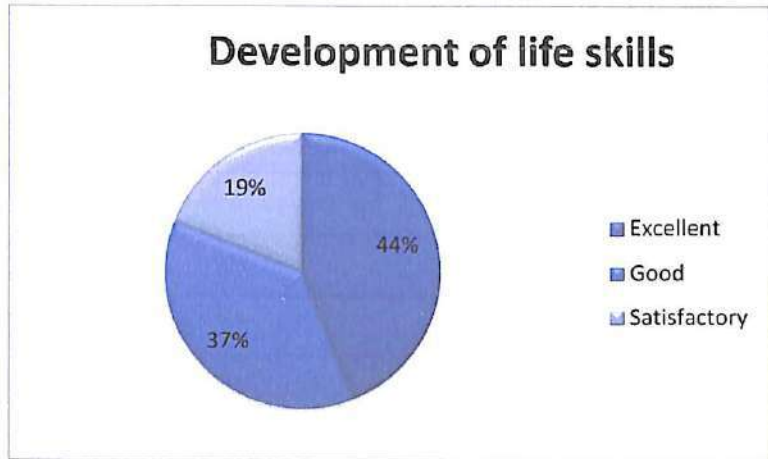
5. Effectiveness in developing life skills.

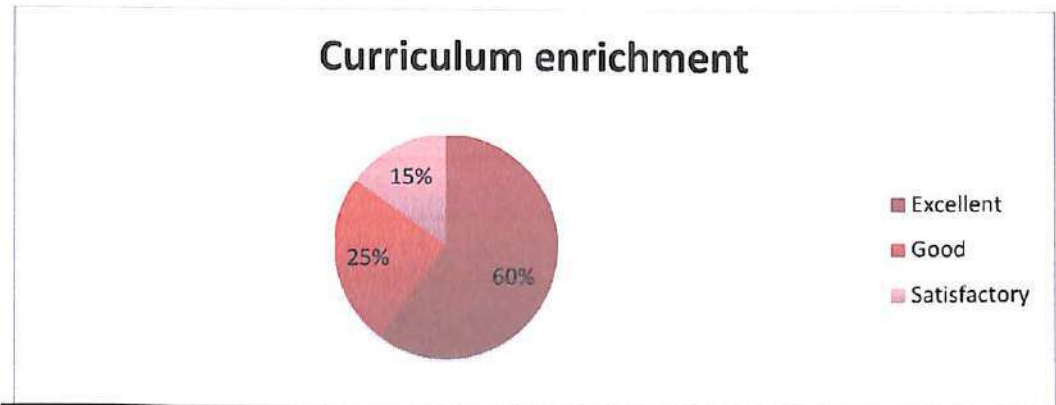

Satisfactory	15%



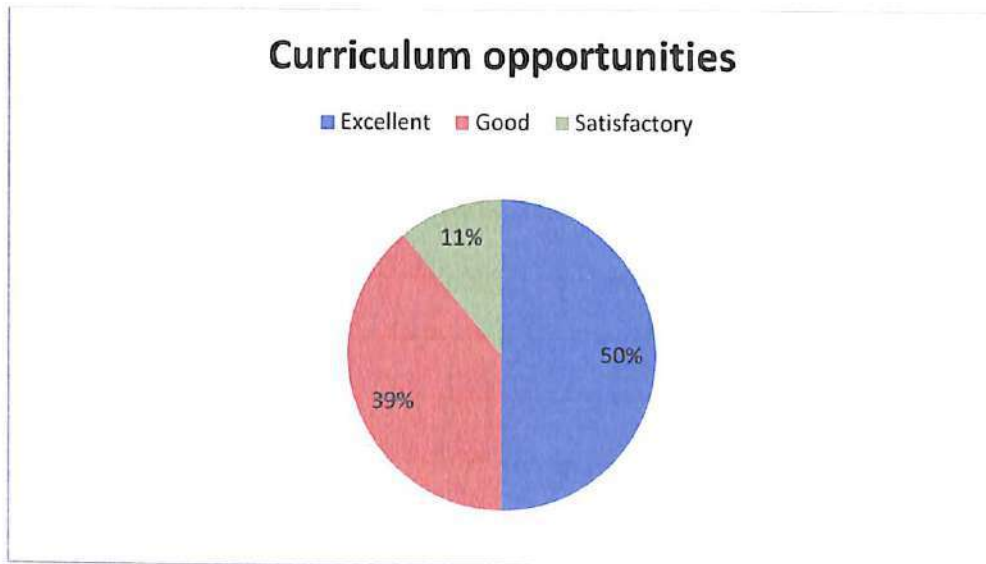

Satisfactory	11%



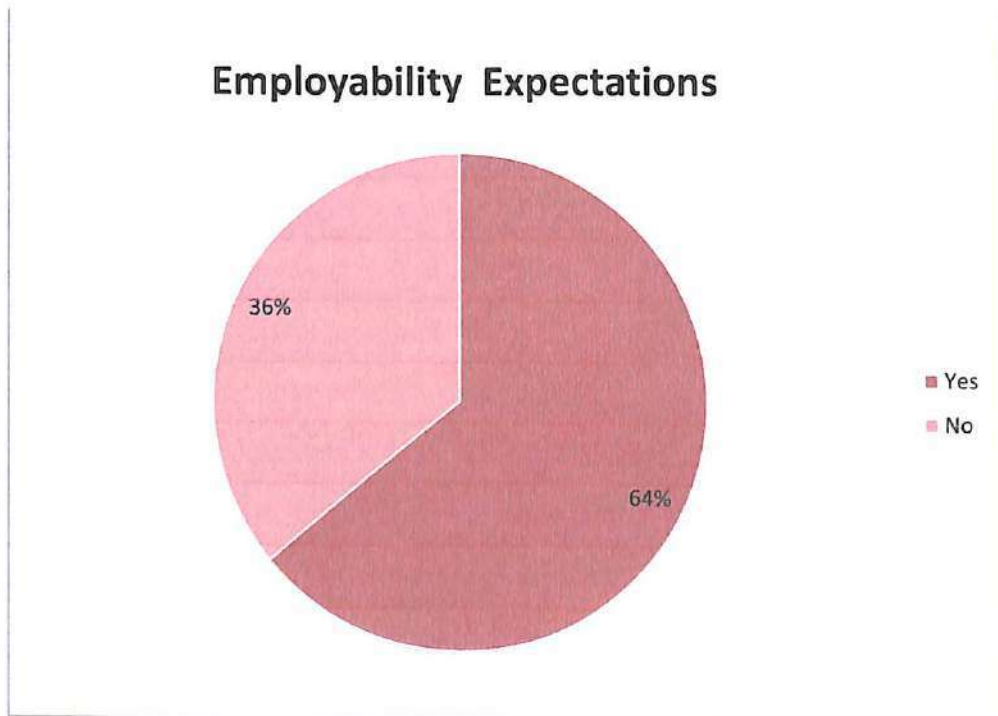

FINDINGS

The study aims to attain better curriculum feedback from the alumni members (batch 2021-22). The questionnaire 'Alumni feedback on curriculum' focus on 10 questions which includes **9 multiple choice questions & one descriptive type question**. Therefore, the data is collected by questionnaire method or focusing surveyed/ primary data for this study.

- ✓ Collaborative effort of the institution is excellent in curriculum planning and implementation.
- ✓ 50% of the respondents stated curriculum attainment of objectives and learning outcome is excellent.
- ✓ 52 % of the respondents states that coverage of advanced topics will be excellent and only 16 % respondents states it should be satisfactory.
- ✓ Institution highly enhanced knowledge skills and curriculum.
- ✓ The students achieved several life skills through the institution. The data shows that 44 % of the respondents states that it is very useful and excellent.
- ✓ 56 % of the respondents are agreed to the statement as curriculum implementation integrates issues relevant to gender, values, environment and professional skills.
- ✓ 60 % of the respondents sense that curriculum enrichment process provided motivation for higher education.
- ✓ 50 % of the respondents states that curriculum provided opportunities for self-study and for interest in research
- ✓ 64 % of the respondents are agreed with the statement as curriculum met your employability expectations and 36 % of the students are disagreed with this statement.

Overall, this study reveals that the curriculum of PKM College of Education provides vast space to each students for developing their internal and external potential which contribute to create their own identity.
