Share your Sight: Talking text development project for differently abled

The lockdown in response to the COVID-19 pandemic has interrupted conventional schooling with nationwide school closure. The sudden and nearly complete shift to online education due to the closure of schools amid the pandemic has thrown up many challenges for differently-abled children. They find learning to be challenging due to virtual learning. In this context as a learning support for differently abled children, P.K.M. College of Education launched a curricular project for developing talking text titled *Share Your Sight*.

The project was introduced with the main objective of reducing the inequality rate by making visually challenged children equal in knowledge level through providing learning support in the

form of interesting audio series. The project also aims to make the student teachers produce appropriate positive behaviours that meet the needs of visually challenged individuals in society. As part of the programme, a two-day online workshop was conducted to train the student teachers in talking text development starting from script preparation. The workshop was inaugurated by Mr. Diego Jolly Jacob, Head, On Air promotion dept. SURYA T V. The technical sessions were handled by Dr. Rameshan Kador, senior lecturer DIET Kannur on day one and Mr. M K Haridasan, Special educator, Samagra Shiksha Kannur on day 2. The discussion of day one focused on Inclusion in Secondary Education: Teaching and Learning Package Development. The day 2 discussions focused on Talking Texts for the Visually Challenged. The workshop was also part of EPC 03: Enhancing Professional Competency & ICT, and B ED C403. Creating and Inclusive School courses.

Pragya & Scholastica: Learning Support System for Students at Risk

Pragya and Scholastica are learning support systems for students at risk. Both are online learning support systems introduced under the leadership of the student teachers of PKM College of Education for secondary school students who felt difficulties in their learning during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The programme was a resounding success and a shining example of the social commitment of PKM College of Education Madampam. During the pandemic, with the help of teachers and student teachers, PKM College conducted online tuition classes for high school students in English, Malayalam, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Mathematics and Social Science subjects. The learners were divided into different groups consisting 12 members and provided mentors to guide and support them. A meagre fee was collected from the learners to ensure responsible learning and classes were conducted through Zoom and Google Meet platforms. The overwhelming response and active participation of school students marked the success of the programme. The programme became quite handy for the children in the vicinity of the college as many children faced tremendous difficulties in continuing their education with quality due to the characteristics of the locality and network issues.

For the student teachers, it became an eye opener in many ways as they also did not expect such a crisis. Along with their studies, student teachers dedicated time to prepare notes and learning materials for the students at risk thereby extending their heling hand towards the needy.

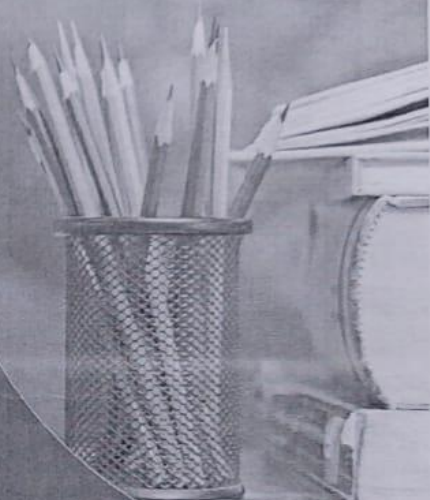

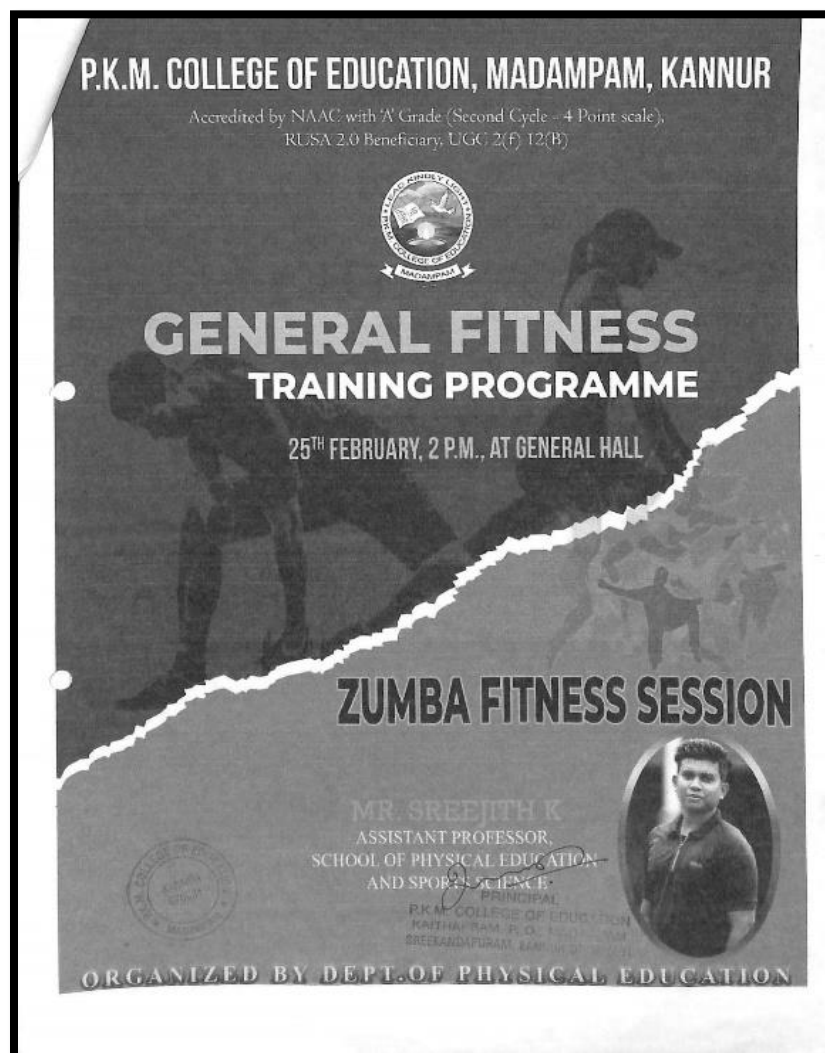
