Pre-internship orientation programme for English optional was organised by P. K. M. College of Education, Madampam on 24th September 2022 at 09:45 am. T. M. Ramachandran of GHSS, Nedungome was invited as the district resource person who hoard a rich knowledge in the pedagogy of English language. Dr. Rekha K R, assistant professor, delivered the welcome address enunciating on the need to squeeze the best of the exceptional teacher through interactions and attentive behaviour, and flagging off for the beginning of the class consisting 7 optional students-teachers.

The pre-internship class included various language games, a discussion on grammar rules, discourses and an interactive session with the resource person. T. M. Ramachandran emphasised the importance of activities in the classroom and the need to convert language classes into activity based zones. Through vocabulary games such as make-many-words-from-one-word, crossword puzzle, riddle and fill the grid, he mentioned on how activities should be challenging, participatory, should have the participation of a student at least on one stage of the activity and should never divert from the learning objective. Mr. Ramachandran is of the




  
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view that silence and discipline should never reign on in language classes as it hinders free participation and interacting opportunities.

The internship programme moved forward with the resource person hinting on the various grammatical rules that are included in high school classes, which the student-teachers need to be aware of and thorough, to take classes for the young children. He touched upon word pyramid, editing, numbers, past tense, modal auxiliaries, and questions tags. The significance of discourses was also mentioned with which the learners indulge more deeply with the text; and the need for the ability of teachers to find slots in the text to give questions of discourses. He exemplified on how to give discourse question through the story *The Hare and the Tortoise* such as letter writing, profile writing, notice writing, appreciation, character sketch and more. Interactive session followed where student-teachers raised their concerns of real classroom situation and how to manage it. Mr. Ramachandran stressed on the need for preparation, confidence on the content to be taught and need for interactive, activity based classes where learners can learn freely. The programme came to an end with vote of thanks proposed by the student-teacher Karishma Suresh at 01:00 pm.

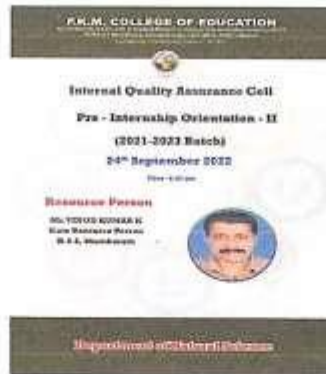

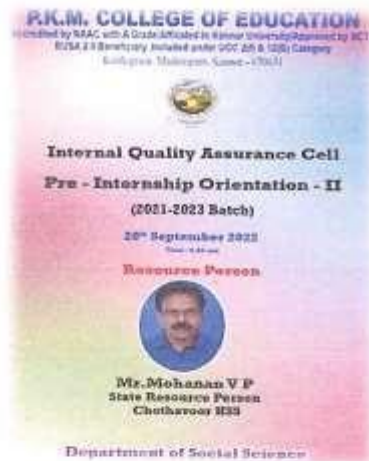

### Name of the programme : LIBRE SOFTWARE TRAINING AND IT QUIZ

A Libre software training programme and an IT quiz was conducted by the members of Little Kites, Sacred Heart Higher Secondary school, Payyavoor, for the student teachers of P. K. M College of Teacher Education, Madampam, on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2022 at 2pm in the general auditorium. The programme began with a prayer by Ms Sreethu M (Dept. of social science). While Dr Sr Jessie N C (principal, P.K.M College of Education) presided over the function, Mr Libin K Kurian (Kite Master, Sacred Heart HSS) welcomed the gathering. The chief guest Dr K V Philomina (chairperson, Sreekandapuram Municipality) delivered the inaugural speech. Mr Biju Simon (principal, Sacred Heart HSS) gave a concise overview of the topic. In his address Dr Prashanth Mathew ( Vice Principal, P.K.M College of Education) praised the Little Kites members for undertaking such programmes and wished for its success. Master James Shybu (Student, Little Kites) was in charge of the next session which dealt with the free software Open Office Impress. Impress is an open office tool to create presentations. It's very similar to Microsoft's PowerPoint. Impress can handle both Microsoft's PowerPoint format as well as its own open standard format called open document presentation format. The last session of the training programme was taken by Ms Liya Johnson (Student, Little Kites) which was about the software LibreOffice Writer. Writer is a word processor similar to Microsoft Word and Corel's WordPerfect with many similar features, and file format compatibility.

The IT Quiz session was led by Mr Abhinav Stephen and Varsha Pradeep ( Both students, Little Kites). A total of fifteen questions were asked in the quiz session in which Mr Akhil C K (Dept. of Malayalam), Akshay G (Dept. of Mathematics) and Aleena James (Dept. of Malayalam) secured first, second and third positions. The programme came to an end at 4.45pm with the national anthem.

## INTRODUCTION

'Jeevani - College Mental Health Awareness Programme' is a new venture introduced by Kerala Collegiate Education Department. The programme aims to address the mental health issues and to enhance the psychological well-being of student through individual counseling session, training classes and workshops.

Jeevani Centre for Students Well-being has been functioning in the college from 28<sup>th</sup> October 2021 for the academic year 2021-2022, as part of jeevani project by the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Kerala. The center aims to help students deal with issues they face in their academic and personal lives and to promote student mental health. As the project has only started during this month the primary goal of jeevani was to spread information regarding the functioning and to promote awareness about mental health.

The Jeevani program for the academic year 2023-2024 at P.K.M College of Education commenced on August 10<sup>th</sup>, with the inclusion of Ms. Tweena Suresh, a Consultant Psychologist, who joined as a Psychology Apprentice under the Jeevani cell. Since then, orientation programs, awareness classes, and counseling sessions have been provided to students in need. Notably, this academic year marks the appointment of a psychologist to serve in two colleges, with K.M.M. Govt. Women's College as the primary location and P.K.M. College of Education, Madampam, as an additional institution.

Given the psychologists' responsibilities in two distinct colleges this year, the Jeevani center at K.M.M. Govt. Women's College will adhere strictly to the established timetable. Over the course of a month, ten days of service were dedicated to the additional college, while the psychologist was available at the home station, i.e., K.M.M. Govt. Women's College, for the remaining days. The center opens 30 minutes prior to the college working hours and closes 30 minutes after the conclusion of the working day.

### Objectives

- To spread awareness about Jeevani Students Wellbeing Center, role of Psychologist in Collage and Mental Health.
- To spread awareness about the Importance of Mental Health.
- To enhance Social Skills and life skills among Students.
- To enhance Communication Skill among Students.
- To enhance Problem-Solving Skill among Students.
- To enhance idea of Interview Technique among Students.
- To make Students understand and learn about adaptive Coping Strategies in life.



  
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At P.K.M. College of Education, Principal Dr. Jessy Ne played an important role in unveiling the Jeevani Center for Students' Wellbeing, a transformative initiative designed to enhance the mental health of college students. Dr. Jessy Ne elucidated this new government program, emphasizing its crucial role in fostering the overall betterment of students within the realm of mental health.

During this enlightening introduction, Dr. Jessy Ne not only outlined the significance of the program but also addressed students' inquiries, ensuring a clear understanding of its potential benefits. Subsequently, Psychologist provided further insights, offering detailed explanations to clear doubts and provides a comprehensive understanding of the Jeevani Center's objectives.

This collaborative effort between the Principal and the Psychologist not only exemplifies the college's commitment to student welfare but also reflects a proactive stance in embracing government initiatives that contribute to the holistic development and mental well-being of the students'.

On Thursday, October 12, 2023, a session was conducted under Jeevani Cell centering on the "Problems Faced by Adolescent Students and the Crucial Role of Teachers in Management." Within the academic sphere, teachers play a pivotal and influential role in molding the behavior of students. This influence extends beyond imparting subject knowledge, encompassing the provision of essential support that goes a long way in shaping the overall character of the learners. Teachers act as mentors and guides, offering not just academic insights but also emotional and motivational support, creating a nurturing environment where students feel encouraged to thrive not only academically but also in terms of personal development.

The session delved into the challenges faced by adolescent children in the realm of mental health, emphasizing the need for teachers to play a proactive role in managing these issues within the classroom. Adolescents often grapple with diverse mental health concerns, ranging from stress and anxiety to peer pressure and identity issues. To address these challenges, the discussion centered on the ways in which teachers can contribute to the mental well-being of their students. Strategies such as creating an open and supportive classroom environment, fostering positive peer relationships, and incorporating mindfulness techniques into the curriculum were explored. The importance of recognizing signs of distress and establishing effective communication channels between teachers and students was underscored.



  
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From the very beginning, students have demonstrated a keen interest in the Jeevani Cell, actively seeking information and approaching the cell with inquiries about counseling. Notably, those students who sought individual counseling were promptly attended to and received dedicated care from the counselor.

#### **Nature of the chief complaints observed during sessions:-**

- Decision making difficulties.
- Adjustment issues.
- Interpersonal difficulties.

Based on individual requirements, a follow-up has been recommended for students in need. This personalized approach ensures that ongoing support is provided, aligning with the specific needs identified during counseling or interventions. The proactive recommendation of follow-up sessions reflects the commitment of the institution or counseling services to monitor and address the evolving needs of students over time, fostering a supportive and responsive environment for their overall well-being.

#### **Summary**

The Jeevani Center for Students' Wellbeing at PKM College of Education is working on scheduled days, providing counseling services for students who need support. The entire college community supports this initiative, driven by a shared commitment to uplift the holistic well-being of our students. This program shows commitment to not only academic success but also the mental and emotional health of each student.



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
