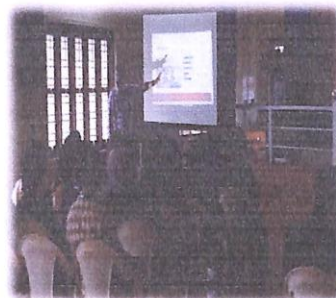

The programme was started exactly 9.30 AM in the college auditorium. The programme started with the prayer of Sanjiya Benny. Natural science teacher Suhaira gave the welcome address. 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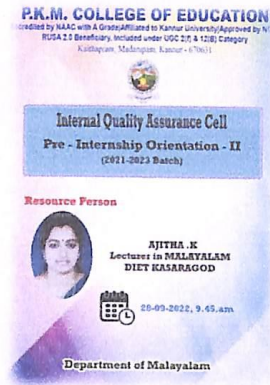
view that silence and discipline should never reign on in language classes as it hinders free participation and interacting opportunities.

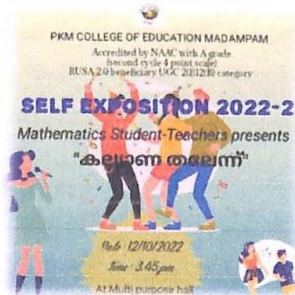

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Name of the programme : Self Exposition – Mathematics, Date: 12-10-2022:

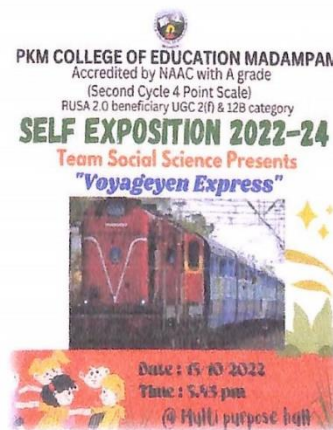

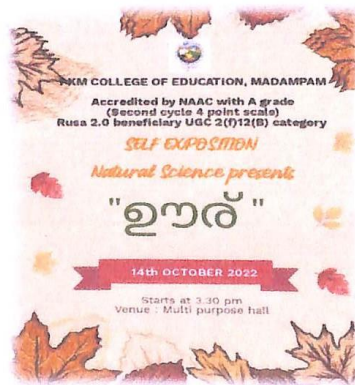

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Name of the programme : Self Exposition – Natural science

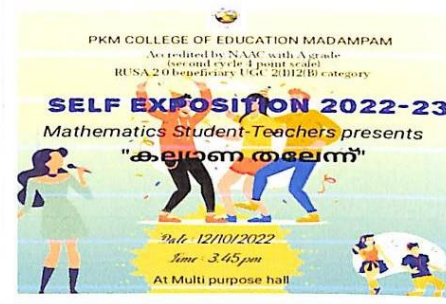

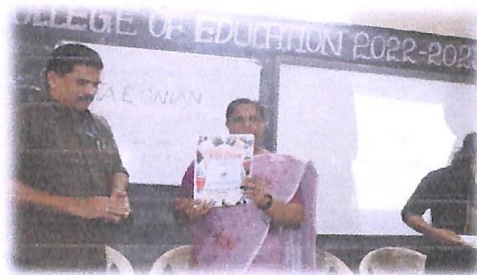
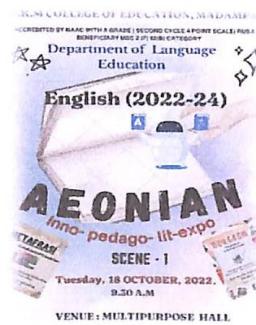
Metafrazi – the audio book – was launched by Dr Prashanth Mathew. Mr Jyothis Cyriac

Interactive session

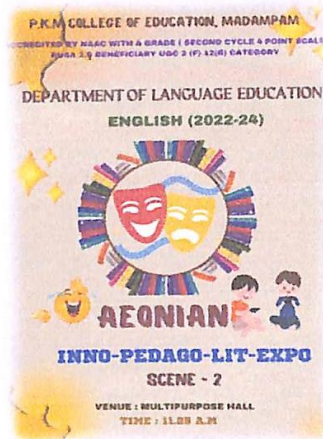

Teachers, non-teachers and an alumni representative Ms. Marisa Marcos participated and made the programme a great success. Students of the Malayalam department led the programme.



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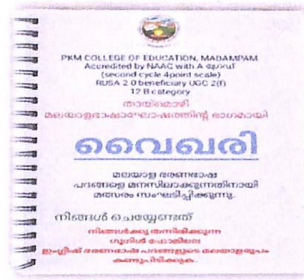

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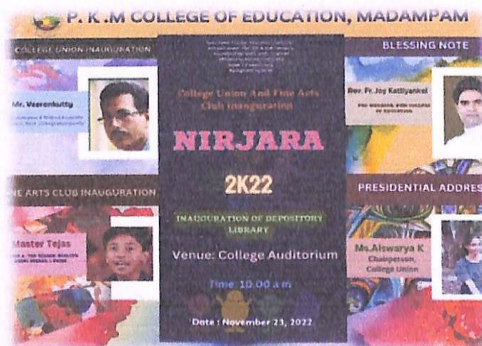
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of his poems. The formal session ended with a vote of thanks by Hariprasad N, general secretary around 12.30 pm.

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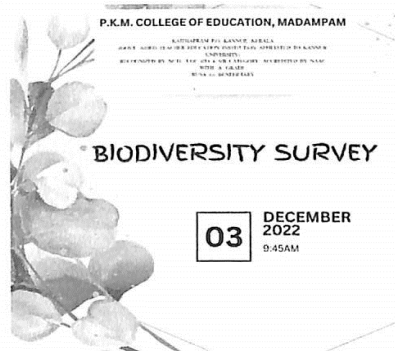

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Name of the Programme: Organised Bio-Diversity Survey

BIODIVERSITY SURVEY REPORT



Bhoomithrasena Club and the Natural Science department of P. K. M. College of Education, Madampam collectively conducted a Biodiversity survey on 3rd December 2022. Students of the college were surveyed by grouping into three. All the groups were allotted to three different locations in Madampam. Each student was asked to collect at least 2-3 plants.

The first group of the survey contained 9 student teachers of the college from different optional subjects. The field of survey was the P. K. M. College-Madampam Road. The survey started at 9:45 am and every student was asked to collect at least two different plants. The group had a thorough observation of the area and collected about 30 plant materials including shrubs and herbs of different plant families. The collected materials were pressed on site and pictures regarding the whole procedure were taken. The survey ended at 11.30 pm.

The second group of survey contained 9 student teachers of the college from different optional subjects. The field of survey was the P. K. M. College-Madampam Road. Survey started at 9:45 different plant families. Further procedures were done after reaching college. The team reached college at 11.30 am. The group had a thorough observation of the area and collected about 30 plant materials including shrubs and herbs of different plant families.

The third group contained 8 student teachers of the college which was led by Hariprasad N and Aiswarya P V. The field of survey was Madampam – 56 road. Survey started at 10.00 am and each of the students' collected plants from the allotted area. The group moved along the road up to 2 km and collected almost 33 plants including Trees, shrubs and also herbs of

different families. The collected plant specimens were pressed on the site itself using newspaper. The team reached back college by 12.00 pm.

The pictures of plant collection were taken properly. Students tried to identify and study more about the plants using previous knowledge, technical help and also enquiring to expert teachers. 
FIELD TRIP

BIODIVERSITY SURVEY REPORT



Bhoomithrasena Club and the Natural Science department of P. K. M. College of Education, Madampam collectively conducted a Biodiversity survey on 3rd December 2022. Students of the college were surveyed by grouping into three. All the groups were allotted to three different locations in Madampam. Each student was asked to collect at least 2-3 plants.

The first group of the survey contained 9 student teachers of the college from different optional subjects. The field of survey was the P. K. M. College-Madampam Road. The survey started at 9:45 am and every student was asked to collect at least two different plants. The group had a thorough observation of the area and collected about 30 plant materials including shrubs and herbs of different plant families. The collected materials were pressed on site and pictures regarding the whole procedure were taken. The survey ended at 11.30 pm.

The second group of survey contained 9 student teachers of the college from different optional subjects. The field of survey was the P. K. M. College-Madampam Road. Survey started at 9:45 different plant families. Further procedures were done after reaching college. The team reached college at 11.30 am. The group had a thorough observation of the area and collected about 30 plant materials including shrubs and herbs of different plant families.

The third group contained 8 student teachers of the college which was led by Hariprasad N and Aiswarya P V. The field of survey was Madampam – 56 road. Survey started at 10.00 am and each of the students' collected plants from the allotted area. The group moved along the road up to 2 km and collected almost 33 plants including Trees, shrubs and also herbs of

different families. The collected plant specimens were pressed on the site itself using newspaper. The team reached back college by 12.00 pm.

KERALA SCHOOL EDUCATION CONGRESS APRIL 2023- PROGRAMME REPORT

'Kerala School Education Congress' under the leadership of SCERT with the aim of promoting research activities in the field of education was held at Vellar Craft Village on 1st, 2nd and 3rd April 2023. About 300 delegates from different parts of the country presented 180 research papers under 9 sub-themes. PKM College of Education, Madambam was represented by 30 student teachers and one female teacher. 15 papers were presented from PKM College. Out of 15 papers, 11 poster presentations and four oral presentations were held.

1/4/2023

Registration for the program started on Sunday 1/4/2023, the first day of the Kerala School Education Congress from 9 am to 10 am. After that, the opening ceremony started at 10 am. 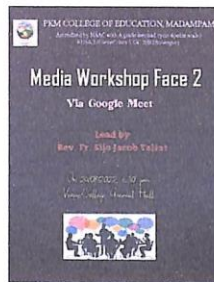

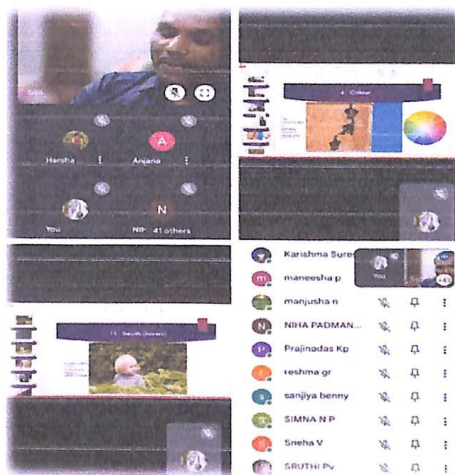

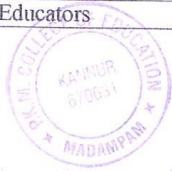
