ACTION TAKEN REPORT

- a) Enhance Communication: Initiate communication channels between the college and employers to further understand specific areas of the curriculum that are well-received and areas that might need improvement.
- b) Curriculum Improvement: Consider the feedback on the B.Ed. curriculum and identify specific areas for improvement based on employer suggestions.
- c) Regularly update and adapt the curriculum to meet the evolving needs of the school system.

- e) Strengthen Values Inculcation: Explore ways to enhance opportunities for inculcating values within the curriculum, as this is an area where some improvement is suggested.
- f) Integrate Technology: Continue integrating the latest technological developments into the curriculum, and perhaps explore additional ways to enhance this aspect based on the feedback.
- g) Life Skills Development: While most respondents view life skills development positively, identify areas where improvements can be made and consider incorporating practical, real-world applications into the curriculum.
- h) Professionalism Development: Strengthen and promote elements of the curriculum that contribute to the development of professionalism, as a high percentage of employers agree on its effectiveness.

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FINDINGS

- Most of the employers are responded that the curriculum provided by university was good.
- More than 75% of the employers responded that the curriculum satisfied with the current needs of school system.
- Most of the respondents said that the curriculum is able to applying the skills and knowledge in professional career.
- About 80% of the employers said that curriculum provide the opportunities for inculcating values
- More than 80 % of the respondents said that curriculum is compatible with the latest technological development.
- Most of the respondents said that the curriculum in terms of life skills was good.
- More than 85% of the employers responded that the curriculum is capable of developing professionalism.
