ACTION TAKEN REPORT

- **Address the 25% Concern About Relevant Topics:** The feedback suggests that 25% of respondents believe that some relevant topics are not present in the curriculum. It would be helpful to conduct a detailed analysis to identify these topics and consider incorporating them into the curriculum, ensuring a comprehensive coverage of relevant content.
- **Enhance Learning Resources:** Although 85% of respondents believe that the effectiveness of learning resources used by trainees is good, there's always room for improvement. Evaluate the current learning resources and explore opportunities to enhance or diversify them to cater to different learning styles and preferences.
- **Continuous Improvement in Assessment Techniques:** Even though 74% of respondents find the assessment and evaluation techniques used by student teachers to be good, there is still a portion that may have suggestions for improvement. Encourage the exchange of best practices among teachers, and consider periodic reviews and updates to assessment methods to align with evolving educational standards.
- **Regular Curriculum Review and Update:** To ensure continued effectiveness, conduct regular reviews of the curriculum. Gather feedback from both students and teachers and use this input to make necessary updates, ensuring that the curriculum remains relevant and aligned with the learning needs of the school.
- **Encourage Innovative Teaching Practices:** While the feedback indicates overall satisfaction, consider promoting innovative teaching practices within the curriculum. Encourage teachers to experiment with new approaches and methodologies that can further enhance the learning experience for students.
