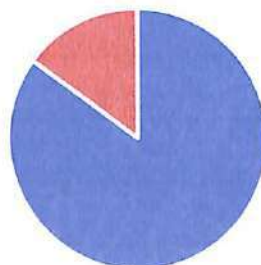

About 85 % of the respondents that the curriculum helps them to carry out their duties effectively. Very few people responded as there is a need for improvement.



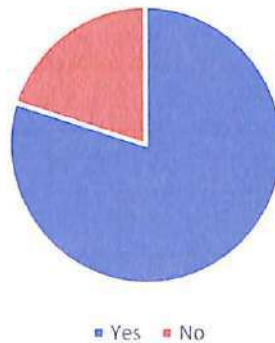

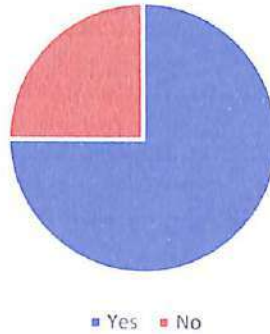

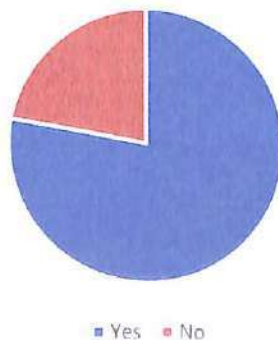

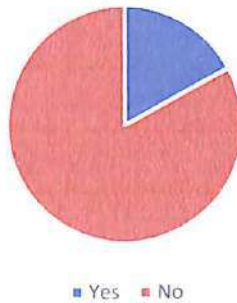

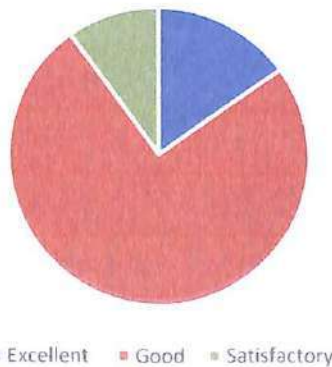

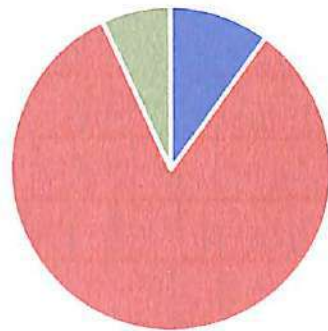

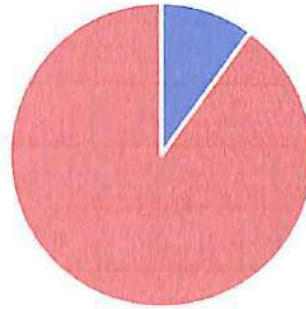
