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## REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON CURRICULUM BY PRACTICE TEACHING SCHOOLS


### ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

#### Growth of trainees through curriculum





The data shows that 90% respondents are agreed with the curriculum enhances the learning experience of students.


3. Did the provided curriculum align with learning needs of the school students.


From the data shows that the curriculum covers learning needs of the school students. 89 % respondents are agreed and 11 % of respondents are disagreed with this statement.




From the above diagram ,56 % of the respondents marks good to the rate of learning resources used by trainees during internship period.25 % of the respondents are satisfied with this statement.

From the above diagram shows that 54 % of the students marks that who has a ability to intergrate technology in teaching learning processes.



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
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The above data shows that assessment and evaluation techniques used by student teachers are good and 20 % students are satisfied with this statement.
