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
REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTIONS FROM THE STUDENTS

Institution's curriculum is a collaborative effort	20.41%	57.14%	8.16%	10.20%	4.00%





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63.26% of the responses indicate that provided value added course improves the professional skills of the students. Only less than 3% of the students argued for better value added courses for improving their professional skills.


4. Curriculum provides opportunities for enriching the knowledge and skills


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5. Curriculum provides opportunities to familiarize with different school system

51.02% of the students strongly agreed that the curriculum provides opportunities to familiarize with different school system. The responses of less than 7% of the students

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
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highlights that the curriculum should provides more opportunities to familiarize with different school system.


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

8. Relevance of the curriculum in the academic scenario




75.51% of the respondents of the feedback indicate that the curriculum meets the expectations of the students. Less than 7% of the students are not satisfied with the existing curriculum.

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
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44.90% of the students felt that the syllabus of the core course is good. 4.08% of the students argued that there must be some improvement in the syllabus of core course.




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57.14% of the students have the opinion that the syllabus of the pedagogic course is good. Less than 3% of the students need some improvement in the syllabus of pedagogic course.



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
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71.43% of the students agreed that the syllabus of EPC course is good for the students. The 4.08% of the students needs much better syllabus for EPC course.




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61.22% of the respondents are satisfied with the syllabus of practicum course. 8.16% of the students want improvement in the syllabus of practicum course.

FINDINGS

Based on the response from the feedback form and open-ended questions following finding were made.

- Most of the students found that the institution curriculum planning gives students the opportunity to work and collaborate together to learn and grow together.
- 2. Students opinioned that the curriculum provides adequate choices for courses and electives to the students.



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- Most of the responses indicate that provided value added course improves the professional skills of the students.
- 4. More than half of the students expresses that the curriculum provides more opportunities for enriching the knowledge and skills of the students.
- Most students strongly agreed that the curriculum provides opportunities to familiarize with different school system.
- Most of the students gave the feedback on curriculum aspects found that the curriculum provides professionally relevant understanding and curriculum experiences during the programmes.
- More than half of the students felt that the curriculum satisfies the stated objectives and learning outcomes.
- 8. Most of the students have the opinion that the curriculum is relevant in the academic scenario.
- More than half of the respondents of the feedback indicate that the curriculum meets the expectations of the students.
- 10. Most of the responses from the students felt that the syllabus of Core Course, Pedagogic Course, Elective Course, EPC Course, Patricum and the syllabus of Value Added course are good.
