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REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTIONS FROM THE STUDENTS

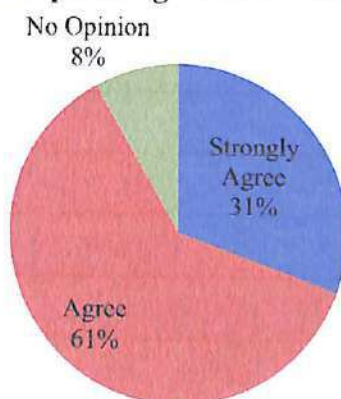
ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21

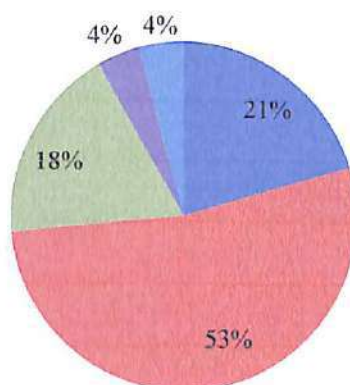

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2. Curriculum provides adequate choices of Courses and Electives to the students

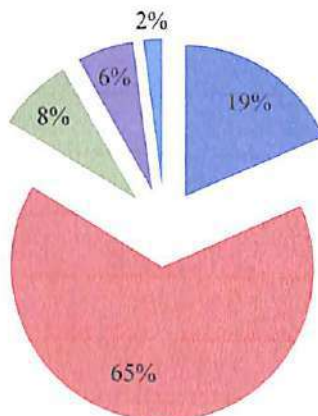



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Professional Skills through Value added Course

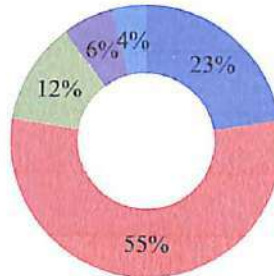

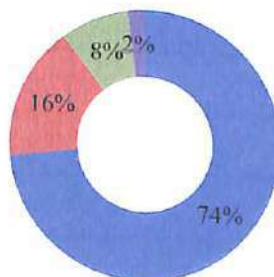
Of all the students of the batch, 78 percent students acknowledged that the curriculum did enrich their knowledge and skills. In the meanwhile 4 percent of the students denied it.

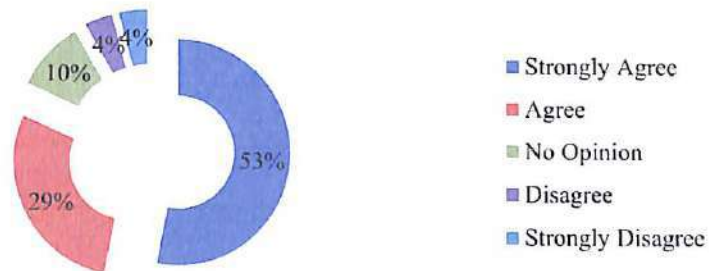
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74 percent of the students acknowledged that the curriculum helped them in acquainting with different school systems. Nobody did deny this totally.

53 percent of the students strongly agreed that they received professionally relevant understanding and curriculum experiences through the program. 4 percent students strongly disagreed the same.

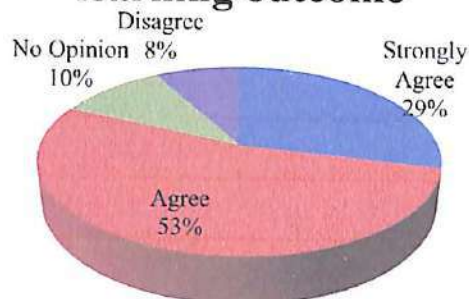
7. Curriculum satisfies the stated objectives and learning outcome

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Attainment of objectives and learning outcome

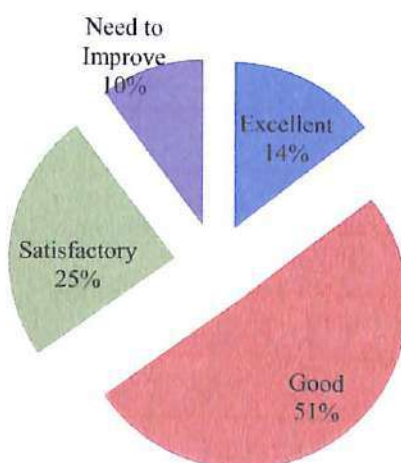

Relevance of curriculum




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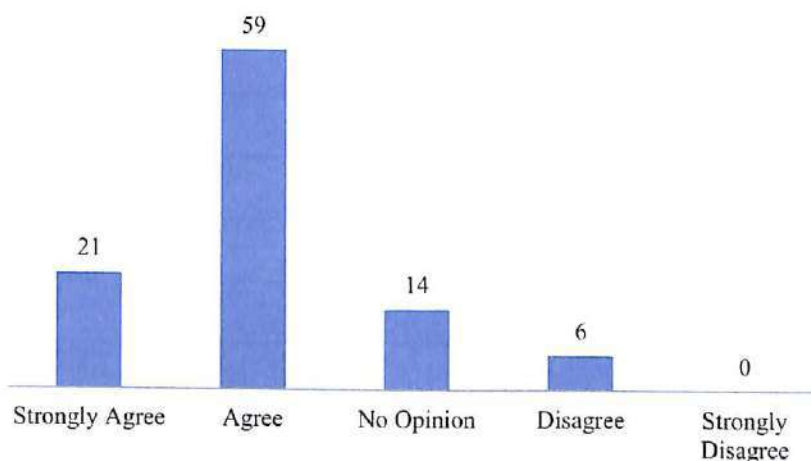
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14 percent of the students agreed that the curriculum was very relevant in the academic scenario and 10 percent suggested that improvement to be made on the curriculum.

Meeting of expectations



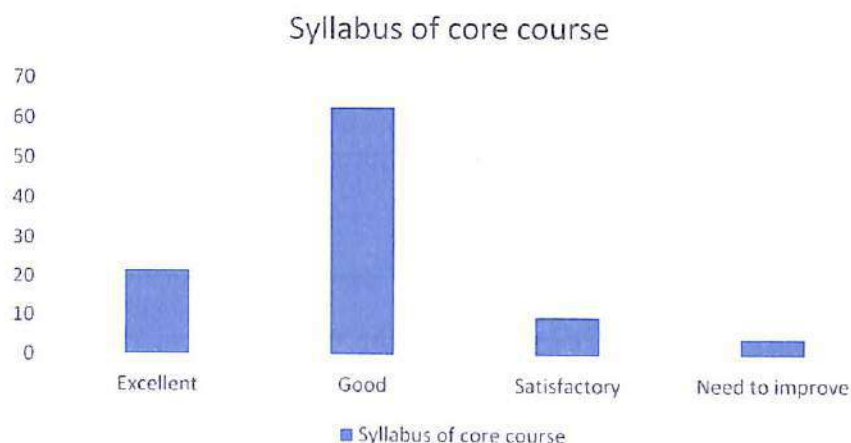
The curriculum met the expectations of a total of 80 percent students, only 6 percent of students were not satisfied.

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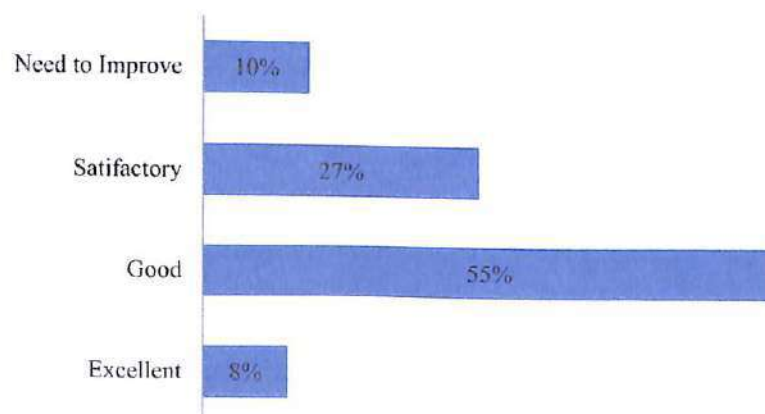


22 percent of students opined that the syllabus of Core Courses were good. 10 percent students suggested that improvement was need for the syllabus of Core Courses.

55 percent of students opined that the syllabus of Pedagogic Courses was good and 10 percent opined that it require improvements.

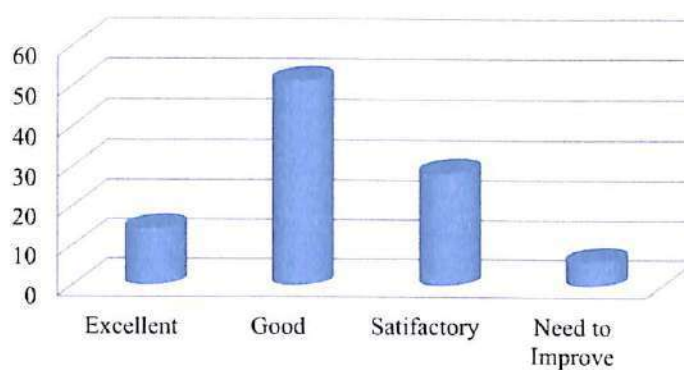

Syllabus of Elective Courses

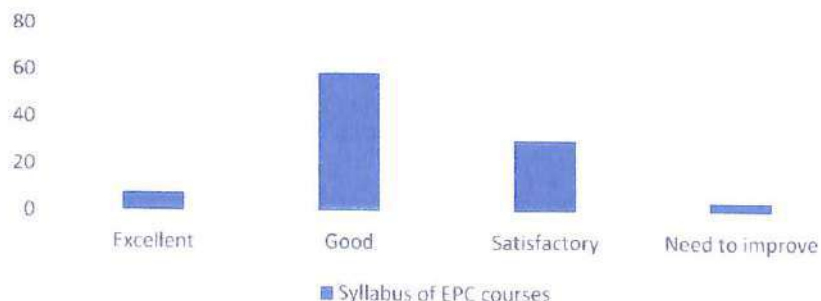



14 percent of students opined that the syllabus of Elective courses were excellent. 6 percent felt that the syllabus of Elective courses needed improvement.

Syllabus of EPC courses




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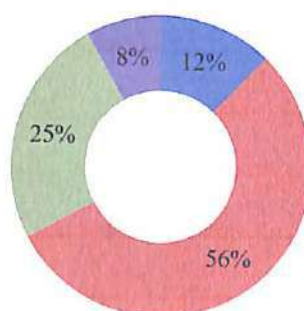
In the case of EPC Courses, 59 percent of students were satisfied with the syllabus. Only less than 3 percent were not satisfied with the syllabus.

56 percent of students opined that the syllabus of the Practicum was good. 8 percent students suggested for improvement.

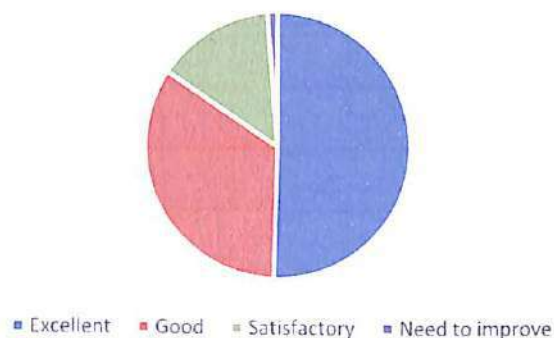

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Syllabus of Value added courses


