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
## REPORT OF THE FEEDBACKS ON THE SYLLABUS AND ITS TRANSACTIONS FROM THE STUDENTS

#### 1. Institution's curriculum planning is a collaborative effort.




Curriculum provides adequate choices of courses and elective to the students.44 % students are strongly agreed and 6 % students are disagreed with these statement.




From the above diagram ,44 % students are agreed with the value added course improves professional skills and only 4% students are disagreed .

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

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

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

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


From the above diagram, 44 % of the students felt that the curriculum satisfies the stated objectives and learning outcomes. And 16 5 students are dissatisfied with this statement.

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

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


From the above data, 38% students sense that the curriculum meets expectations and 16% students are disagreed with is statement.








From the above data, 40 % students who comment on syllabus of elective courses are good. 20 % students are satisfied to study the syllabus of elective courses.

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


The data shows that 38~% students states that syllabus of EPC courses are good. 30~% students are satisfied and 20~% students are not satisfied with the syllabus on core courses.

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
