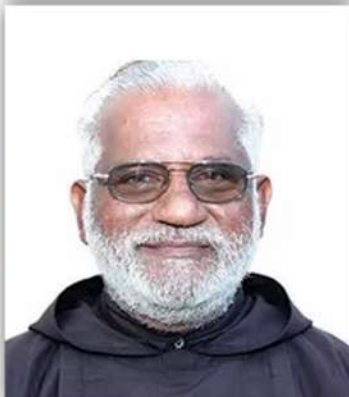

Back Ground

Professor Kandoth Memorial College of Education was established in 1995 as a self financing institution and was converted into an aided college in 1997. This temple of learning is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and named after Prof. Joseph Kandoth, who was an educational visionary, social reformer and a zealous missionary. He initiated the historical migration of Kananaya Catholic Community which in its turn changed the social and economic history of Malabar. 2019-'20 is the Silver Jubilee Year of the college.

Affiliations and Accreditations

PKM College of Education is affiliated to Kannur University and recognised by NCTE. The college is listed under UGC (2f) & 12 (B) categories. The college is accredited by NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) with 'A' grade in 2006 and reaccredited by NAAC in 2016 with 'A' grade (4point scale). It is the only teacher education institution accredited by NAAC in Kannur University. This institution has minority status conferred by National Commission for Minority Educational Institution. 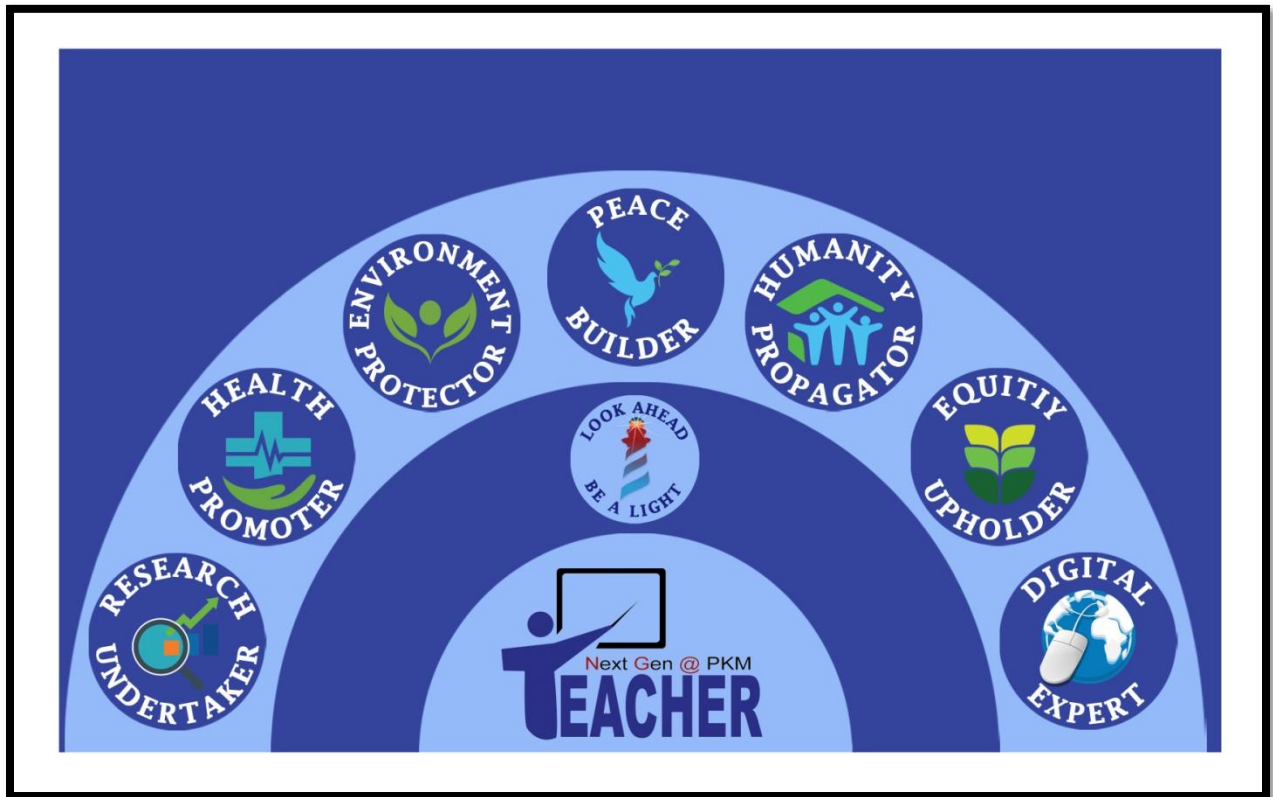

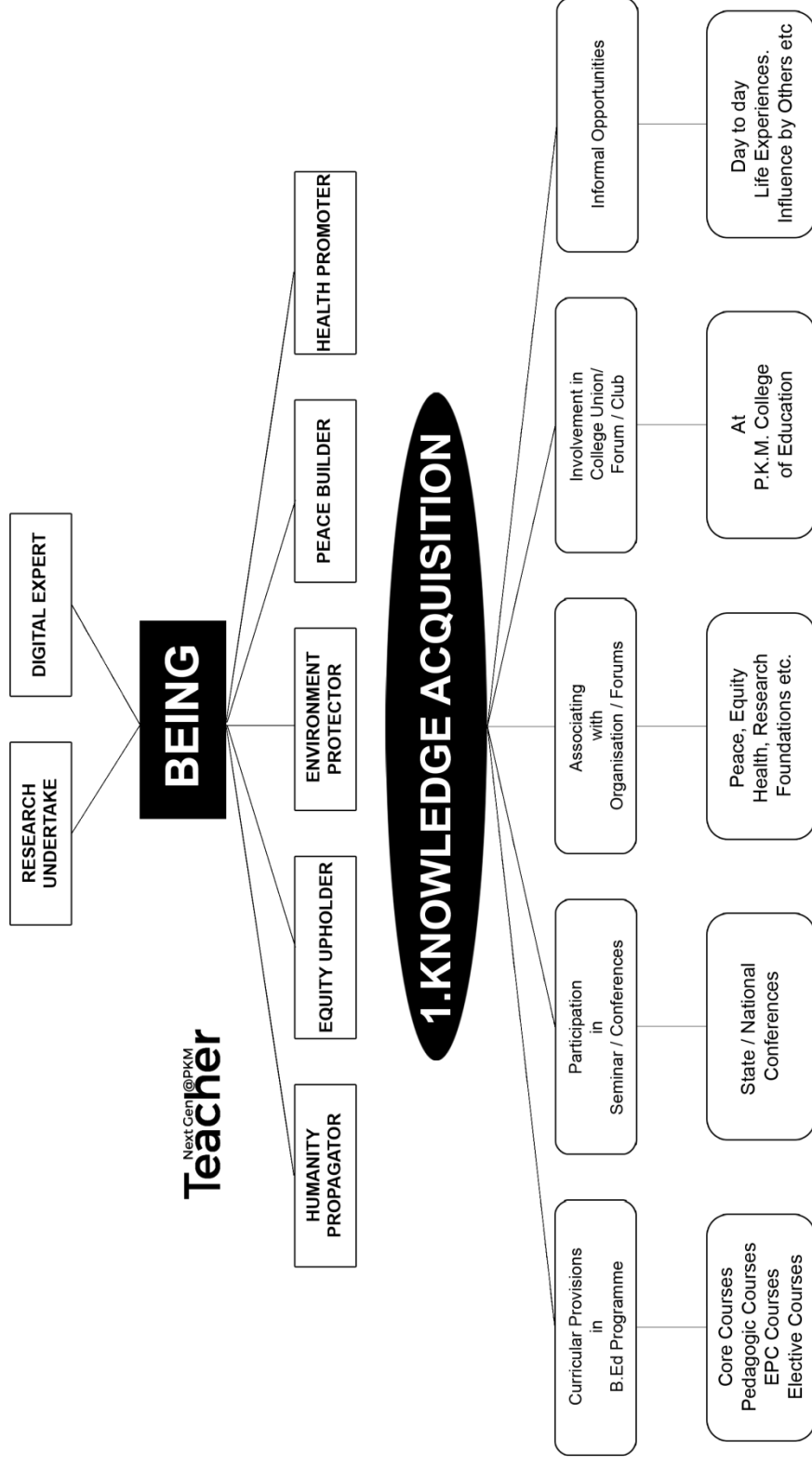
The Curriculum Transaction Processes involves

The **Knowledge Acquisition phase** and the **Skill Acquisition phase**.

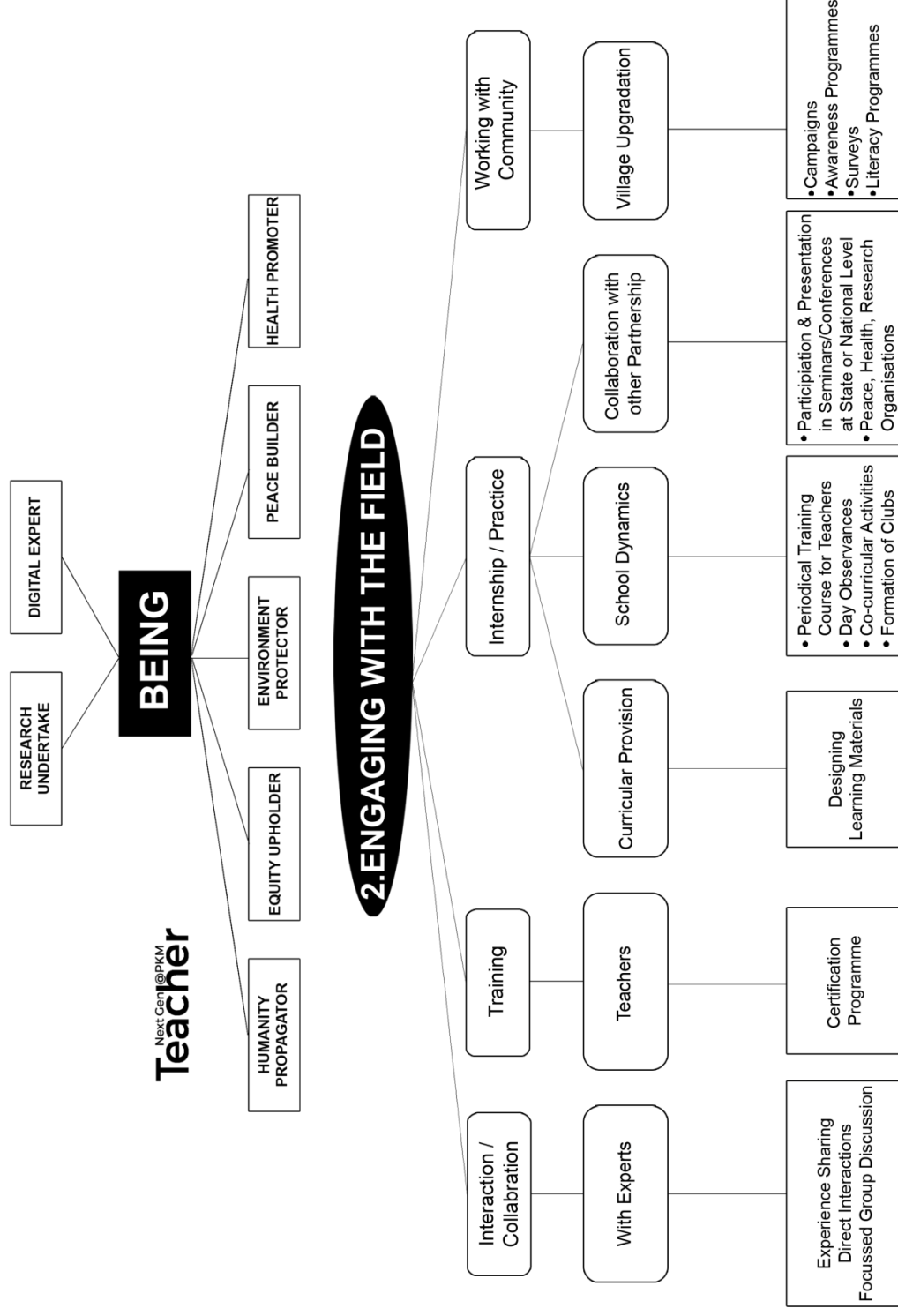

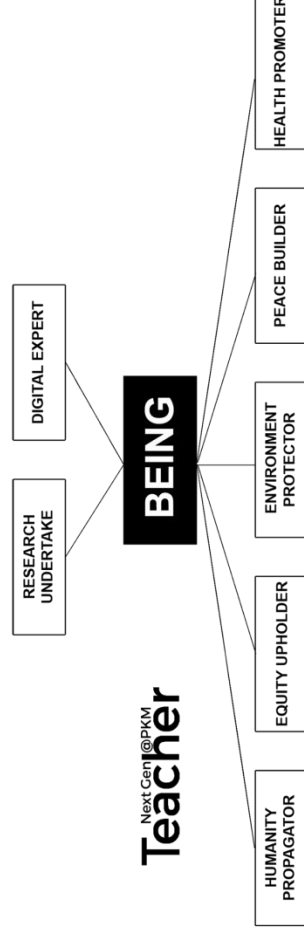
CURRICULAR TRANSACTION PROCESS



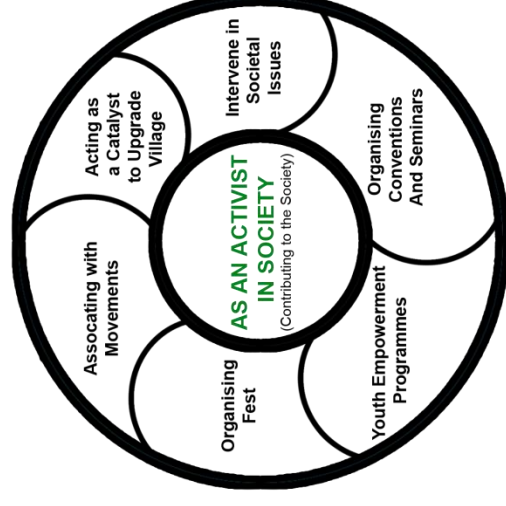
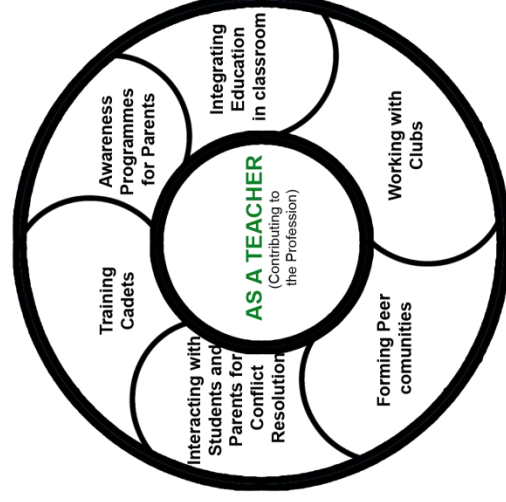
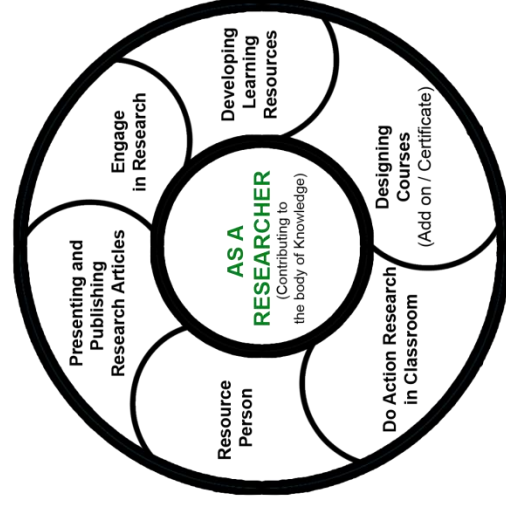
CURRICULAR TRANSACTION PROCESS

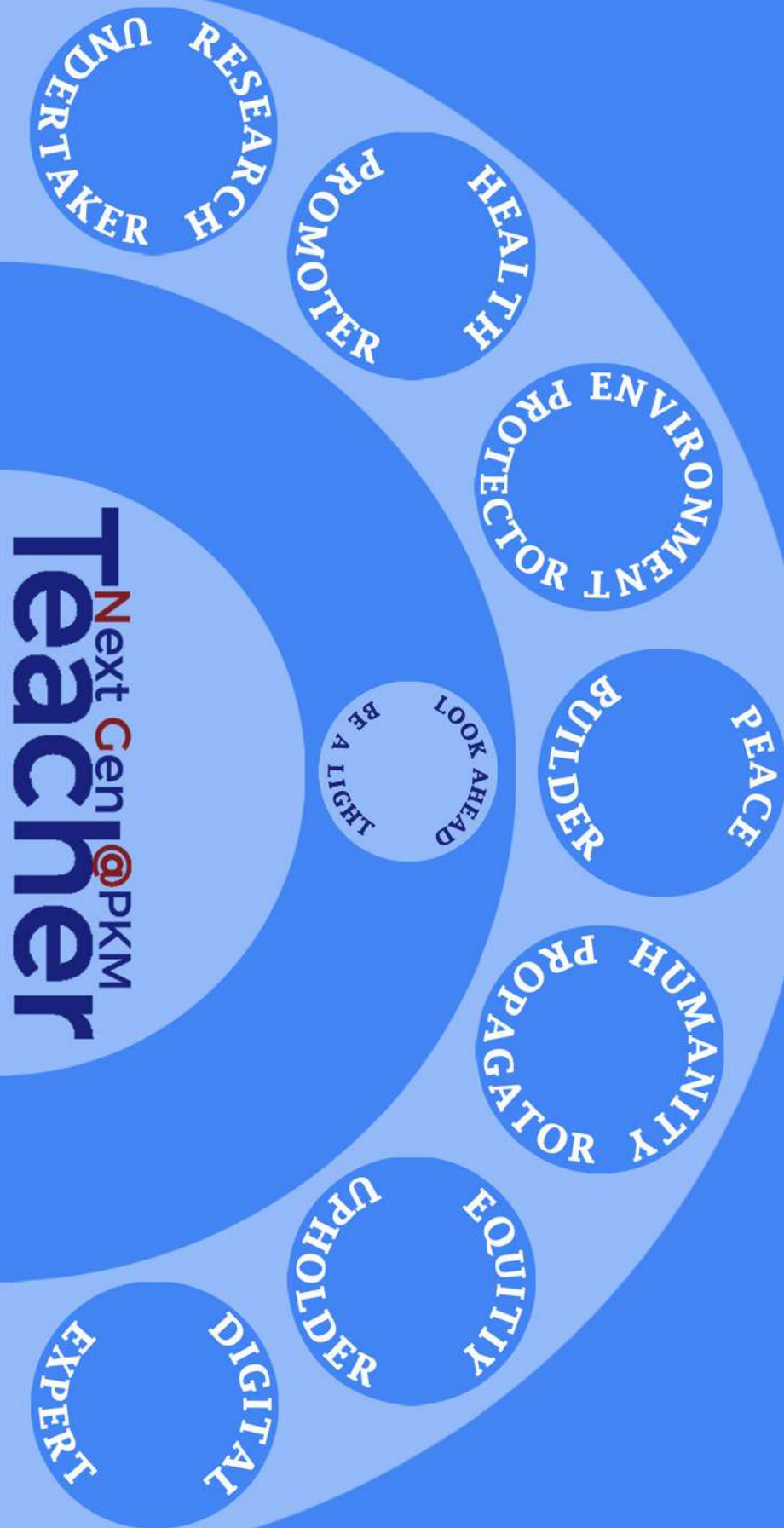
