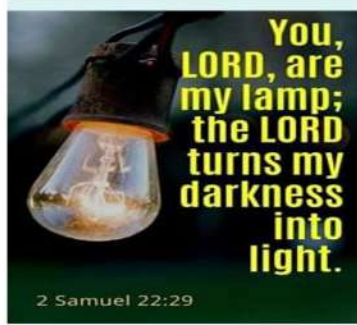


HALLO

Kannur University Inter B.Ed. Volleyball Tournament for the academic year 2025–26 was successfully hosted by P.K.M. College of Education, Madampam on 2nd February 2026. The event commenced with a formal inaugural ceremony, which was graced by Dr. Prasanth Mathew, Vice Principal, RUSA Coordinator, and Head of the Department of Physical Science, who officially inaugurated the tournament. The formal inauguration of the tournament was officiated by Dr. Prasanth Mathew, Vice Principal, RUSA Coordinator, and Head of the Department of Physical Science. In his inaugural address, he emphasized the importance of sports activities in the holistic development of students. A total of eight matches were conducted as part of the tournament. In the preliminary rounds, the teams from Government Brennen College of Teacher Education, Jaybees Training College of B.Ed., P.K.M. College of Teacher Education, and Rajeev Memorial College of Teacher Education emerged victorious and advanced to the next stage. In the subsequent matches, P.K. M. NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY - SCIFIESTA 2025-26

College of Education, Madampam, organized the National Science Day Celebration along with the valedictory function of the year-long science initiative “SCIFIESTA 2025–26” on 20 February 2026 at the College Auditorium. The programme was presided over by the Principal, Dr. Jessy N. C., and the introductory address was delivered by Dr. Prasanth Mathew, Vice Principal and SCIFIESTA Coordinator. The newly elected Municipal Chairman of Sreekanthapuram Municipality, Adv. E.V. Ramakrishnan, and Ward Member Biju Thomas were honoured during the function. Adv. E. V. Ramakrishnan, inaugurated the National Science Day Celebration. Ward Member Biju Thomas announced the college’s partnership with the Ozone Secretariat under the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP). Felicitations were offered by Dr. Veenamma Appukkuttan (IQAC Coordinator) and College UUC Akshara S. Manohar. The vote of thanks was delivered by Sreya K. K. The programme aimed at promoting scientific temper and social responsibility and saw active participation from school and college students. The highlight of the event was the keynote address by Dr. Johnson M. A., a national award-winning researcher who developed the world’s first LED lighting system using 230-volt AC power. Despite facing physical challenges as a polio survivor, Dr. Johnson overcame numerous hardships and established himself in the field of research. An interactive session and LED light assembling workshop were also conducted as part of the programme.

ART AND DRAMA WORKSHOP - ECLEDHARA

PKM College of education organised a series of creative and informative workshops under the banner of arts and drama: way to creativity from 23rd February to 6th of March. Workshops were highly interactive, creative, and informative for all the participants. On the first day of Workshop Series was conducted on 24th February and was led by Nipun T. The Institution Innovation Council of P.K.M College of Education organized a presentation and reflection session on “STEM @ PKM” on February 11, 2026, from 9.30 am to 11.00 am at the College Auditorium. The programme was conducted as part of the institutional initiatives under STEM Phase I (April 2025 March 2026) to strengthen STEM education in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP 2020). The session began with an introductory address by Dr. Prasanth Mathew, who elaborated on the origin and vision of the STEM initiative at PKM. He explained that the initiative commenced with an orientation on the importance of STEM education in the context of NEP during SCIFIESTA 2025, aiming to promote scientific temper, innovation, critical thinking, and interdisciplinary learning among student-teachers. He outlined the initial activities, including orientation sessions on STEM pedagogy, collaboration with robotics experts to strengthen STEM education, and the inauguration of STEM @ PKM by Irikur MLA Sajeev Joseph. He also highlighted the organization of a five-day short-term training course for student-teachers and structured school-based engagement initiatives.
