During the session, Mr. Paul shared insightful perspectives on the future of robotics and the growing role of AI in upcoming generations. He provided a deeper understanding of STEM and its applications within the future educational landscape. The address was given by Dr. Veena Appukuttan, the IQAC coordinator. Dr. Jessy N.C.
