TREKKING PROGRAMME – RANIPURAM

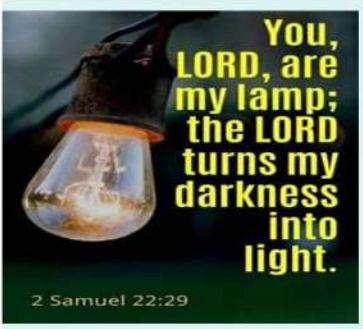
