### STAFF ASSOCIATION MEETING

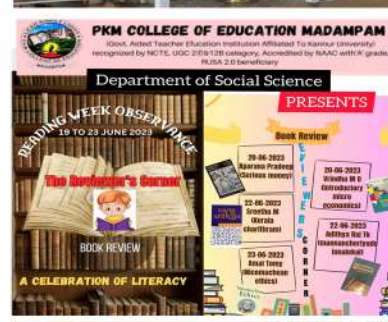
