### Wheel Chair Distributio

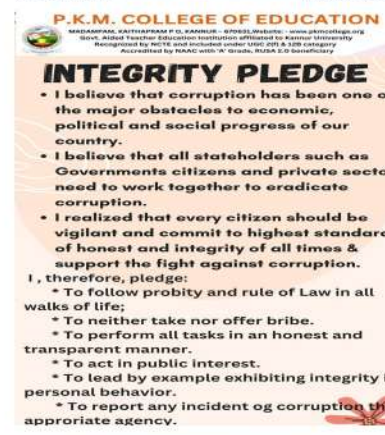
