Kannur University Inter Collegiate Basketball Tournament

Our college hosted for the Intercollegiate Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament for the 2023-2024 academic year. Dr. Sinoj Joseph, Head of Physical Education Department was the tournament coordinator. The decision to conduct the tournament on October 30th and 31st, 2023, was made. Ashwin Baburaj and Gokul were assigned as student coordinators. Subsequently, the registration, refreshments, documentation, and other committees were formed to manage the event efficiently, along with the appointment of volunteers and referees for the competition. Registration started at 9:00 AM. At 9:30 AM, the official inauguration ceremony took place with Dr. Sinoj Joseph, the tournament coordinator, welcoming everyone. Dr. Jessy N.C., the Principal, adorned the position of Chief Guest and officially inaugurated the tournament. Afterwards, participants from various colleges in the sports department gathered to offer their best wishes. The women's basketball tournament featured teams from Govt. Brennen College, Kanhangad Nehru College, Krishnan Menon Smaraka Vanitha College, Chinmaya College, Don Bosco College, and S. E. S. College. In the first match, Govt. Brennen College and Nehru College competed, with Govt. Brennen College emerging victorious with a score of 22-18. The first match concluded at 11:30 AM. In the second match, Chinmaya College and Krishna Menon Smaraka Vanitha College faced off, with Krishna Menon Women's College winning 37-0. At 12:15 PM, Don Bosco College and Govt. Brennen College played their match, with Don Bosco College prevailing with a score of 20-3. This match ended at 12:40 PM. Finally, at 12:50 PM, S. E. S. College and Krishna Menon Smaraka Vanitha College competed, and S. E.S. College won with a score of 15-10. At 1:00 PM, registration for the men's teams began, and the teams had a 45-minute lunch break. After the break, competition resumed. Initially, in the men's basketball competition, Govt. Brennen College and S.E.S. College faced off, with S.E.S. College emerging victorious with a score of 0-17. In the end, S.E.S. College secured the first position, Don Bosco College the second, and Krishna Menon Smaraka Vanita College the third in the women's category. Winners of the competition were honored by Dr. Anoop, the Assistant Director of Physical Education at Kannur University. Subsequently, the final match for men was played between Nehru College and Don Bosco College, with Nehru College emerging as the champions with a score of 93-38 points, becoming the winners of the men's division. In finals, Nehru College secured the first position, Don Bosco College took the second position, and S.E.S.College finished in the third position. The tournament concluded at 1:30 PM. During the closing ceremony, Dr. Jo Joseph (Deputy Director of Physical Education, Kannur University), Dr. Sister Jessy M.C. (Principal, P.K.M.
