SCIFIESTA INAUGURATION AND WORLD OZONE DAY CELEBRATIONS - 2025


World Ozone Day 2025 celebrations and inauguration of Scifiesta 2025-26 were jointly organized at P.K.M. College of Education, Madampam on 16th September 2025 at 2 pm in the College Video Conference Hall. The programme was organized by the Department of Physical Science in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and the National Service Scheme (NSS). Scifiesta is a series of science-related events spanning from World Ozone Day (16th September) to National Science Day (28th February), with World Science Day (10th November) as an intermediate milestone. World Ozone Day 2025 was observed with the aim of sensitising the student teachers to preserve the ozone layer through responsible action. Dr. M. K. Sathesh Kumar, the renowned Atmospheric Scientist inaugurated the celebrations by releasing the Scifiesta Action Plan and delivering a resource talk on "Can Ozone be Considered as a Trace Species Exhibiting Dual Role" - the protective role of stratospheric ozone versus the harmful effects of tropospheric ozone. It highlighted the importance of aligning scientific progress with sustainable action and summoned the student teachers to act responsibly to safeguard the planet and its life supporting systems. The student teachers actively involved in creating a promo video "Breathe Blue, Live Green"; a documentary titled "Heal the Ozone, Heal Earth" and conducting a poster exhibition on the theme "Our Ozone Our Responsibility". As a symbol of responsible action, they undertook a pledge "Join the Mission: Ozone Warriors Unite" and planted a tree in the campus.

Cultural Extravaganza Enlivens the Event


